

How Do The New PFAS Laws Support Communities?



Acts 200 and 201 granted the DNR access to ~\$133 million in the PFAS Trust Fund. The DNR is developing programs to understand the presence of PFAS throughout Wisconsin and take actions to address it.

Municipal Water And Private Wells

- \$80 million to municipalities to support local priorities, such as sampling:
 - ▶ Private wells and public water systems
 - ▶ Drinking water at daycares and schools
 - ▶ High-capacity wells
 - ▶ Waste products
- \$35 million for the Well Compensation Grant Program



Wastewater General Permit

- Required PFAS monitoring in sewer sludge
- Grants to municipalities to sample for PFAS and implement source reduction



Airports And Industrial Possessors

- \$5.25 million for:
 - ▶ Address PFAS contamination
 - ▶ Conduct voluntary remediation



Other Provisions

- Additional staff for technical support
- Funding for temporary, emergency water
- Sampling of fish and wildlife
