Location & Description: This is a 39-acre feature within the Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park near Twin Lakes. The coordinates for this feature are 42.55522, -88.24022.

Summary: “Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park is a 335-acre park located on the western side of Kenosha County. The park, once the site of a former gravel quarry, features a 39-acre, man-made lake, 8 miles of hiking trails, 30-acres of prairie, and offers residents an array of nature-based park amenities highlighted in the multi-year master plan. The park aims to serve the community and honor veterans while providing a therapeutic outlet. Design of the Honor Plaza is situated in an open setting with a flag-filled backdrop honoring the United States and all military branches. The 39-acre lake within Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park offers the opportunity for users to do free recreational scuba diving, fishing, and recreational watercraft activities. Kenosha County Parks stocks the lake with various fish species on an annual basis with support from the Wisconsin County Conservation Aid Program to allow for more recreational fishing.”
