Freedom Lake Name Proposal

Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park is a 335-acre park located on the most western side of Kenosha County. The park, once the site of a former gravel quarry, features a 39-acre, man-made lake, 8 miles of hiking trails, 30-acres of prairie, and offers residents an array of nature-based park amenities highlighted in the multi-year master plan (https://bit.ly/3I77RoA). In addition, park development endeavors are recommended and highlighted as significant in "A Park and Open Space Plan for Kenosha County" and "A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Kenosha County: 2035."


The park, formerly referred as KD Park, was renamed in 2020 as a tribute for current and past military service veterans. About 7.7% of the Kenosha County population has veteran status, about 10% higher than the rate in Wisconsin and the United States (<u>Census Reporter, 2019</u>). In 2021, Kenosha County completed development of a western access parkway, honor plaza, and approximately three miles of multi-use trail expansion to lay the foundation to incorporate future park amenities. This development project, along with paving of a ½ mile parkway, creation of parking stalls, installation of a boat launch and boarding pier, and trail development have all been partially funded through the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

The park aims to serve the community and honor veterans while provide a therapeutic outlet. Design of the Honor Plaza is situated in an open setting with a flag-filled backdrop honoring the United States and all military branches. The 39-acre lake within Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park offers the opportunity for users to do free recreational scuba diving, fishing, and recreational watercraft activities. Kenosha County Parks stocks the lake with various fish species on an annual basis with support from the Wisconsin County Conservation Aid Program to allow for more recreational fishing.

In 2021, Kenosha Count hosted over 100 veterans, community members, and military dignitaries in the first of what will be generations of ceremonies in dedication of the Honor Plaza at Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park (https://bit.ly/3tcMAFF). This milestone achievement was highlighted and brought media coverage to the site. Future-phase developments of the site includes six memorial shelters, each honoring the branches of the Armed Forces, at key scenic locations throughout the park. Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park is on its way to become the jewel of Kenosha County once all the veteran features are completed.

The formal naming of Freedom Lake incorporates the essence of the park's plan and vision to honor veterans. The lake provides the perfect therapeutic setting for visitors as they traverse the various hiking trails, reflect at the flag walk, and enjoy the natural beauty of the park.
