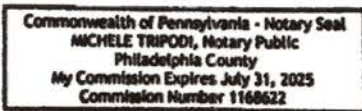

License Renewal Applications - Required Supplemental Information

Green Light Wisconsin LLC's surety bond remains in place in the amount of \$5,000 #SU1181496 issued by Arch Insurance Company located in Jersey City, NJ who is registered to do business in the state of Wisconsin. As previously confirmed by the WDNR, this bond satisfies the minimum amount required under the license and the cost to abandon two open boreholes labeled as R11-11 and R11-12 located at the Reef deposit in Marathon County for which Green Light Wisconsin LLC is responsible.

2. Include information required under s. NR 130.106(1)(d) regarding active notifications of intent to drill submitted by the license under s. NR 130.109

Bend Project, Taylor County

On May 4, 2023, the WDNR authorized the Company's drilling plans for its Bend Project in Taylor County, Wisconsin. The Company had earlier submitted a Notice of Intent to Drill to the WDNR outlining Green Light's plans to drill up to eight holes in the spring/summer of 2023 and/or winter of 2023/24. Further, on May 10, 2023, the Company obtained the required Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) General Permit. Prior to the commencement of any drilling activities, the Company will ensure that certain conditions are met including submitting an updated surety bond with a value of US \$50,000. The Company is currently canvassing the market for bonding quotes. The Company also has an authorization to proceed with the U.S. Forest Service for drilling under frozen conditions. Drilling activities are intended to be conducted this coming 2023/2024 winter.

Reef Project, Marathon County

In 2022, the Company filed a draft Notice of Intent to Drill with the WDNR setting forth plans to drill exploration holes at the Reef Project. WDNR requested further information with respect the Notice to Drill. The Company expects to file a revised Notice of Intent to Drill this year, and once approved, drill REEF this winter 2023/2024.
