Water withdrawal activities are proposed to take place at the indicated location between May-July of 2020.

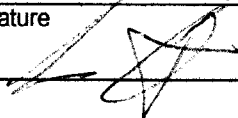
Water will be pumped into a water truck (1000 gallon capacity). A 2" rubber hose with a suction screen will be lowered below the water surface and pumped into the water truck with a 2-3" trash pump. The water truck, along with the pump will remain, at all times, on the roadway to minimize disturbance and prevent sediment from entering the water way. A silt sock will be utilized along the down slope edge of the roadway as an additional measure to reduce sediment from entering the waterway.

Water will be collected from Stockley Creek (see attached figure 1 "Northern Water Source") at a maximum rate of ~12,000 gallons/day for use as a drilling fluid. Throughout the drilling process water is collected periodically on an as needed basis.
