<u>ATV Passenger rules</u> - ATV operators cannot have a passenger riding in or on any part of an ATV that is not designed or intended to be used by passengers. Aftermarket seating does not meet this requirement, therefore passengers are only allowed on ATV's originally designed for two people.

<u>Speed and Reckless operation</u> – ATV's/UTV's/OHM's must be operated less than 10MPH when within 100 feet of a person not on a motorized vehicle. This would include the parking lot and unloading area.

<u>Roadway operation</u> – ATV/UTV/OHM operation is limited to the Bong motorized vehicle trail system. Operation on roadways, hiking trails and other property locations is prohibited.

<u>Accidents</u> – ATV/UTV/OHM crash incidents <u>requiring medical attention</u> require a DNR crash report be completed. Crash reports can be found on the DNR website or by contacting Bong park staff.
