## **Rule Information**

This preliminary hearing will cover Scope Statements for two proposed rulemaking efforts updating ch. NR 809, Wis. Adm. Code:

- The objective of Board Order DG-01-24 is to establish drinking water standards, referred to as Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs), based on the new federal standards for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) set individual MCLs for five of the PFAS, as well as a Hazard Index approach to protect public health from mixtures of these substances. In establishing standards consistent with federal requirements, this rule would revise the state PFOA and PFOS MCLs to be consistent with (no less stringent than) the new federal MCL standards for PFOA and PFOS, as required under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA).
- The objectives of Board Order DG-02-24 are to:
  - Clarify and correct existing requirements to meet the requirements of the EPA and the SDWA.
  - Establish a definition, address redundancies and omissions, clarify to improve understanding and readability, and correct grammatical, spelling, and punctuation errors.
  - Update Consumer Confidence Report requirements to be consistent with new federal regulations under the SDWA.
