Rule Information: Emergency Board Order FH-18-24 (E) maintains continuity from a previous emergency rule allowing limited walleye harvest by state anglers in the Minocqua Chain of Lakes. This will allow state anglers to continue to participate in the shared Minocqua Chain walleye fishery alongside tribal fishers through the 2024-2025 harvest season. The rule that prohibits the harvest of walleyes will sunset April 1, 2025, so FH-18-24 (E) is being requested to allow walleye harvest and maintain consistency among anglers until the prohibition sunsets.
