Rule Information: Commonly referred to as the wildlife management housekeeping rule, these rule changes are proposed to correct inconsistencies, update outdated language, align rules with statutes, revise scientific and common name spellings, provide clarification when appropriate, and make other minor revisions. All the policies in this rule are consistent with past board policies of regulating fish and game harvest. The changes proposed in this rule will have a minimal impact on the activities of hunters, trappers and individuals seeking scientific collector permits and scientific research licenses. These rules are proposed primarily to maintain consistency with recently revised statutes or to update cross-references.
