

## Minimum Acceptable Bid for Entire Sale: \$6,635.00

<sup>1</sup>Mixed Hardwood Pulp includes 95% red maple and 5% ash.

#### Other species not mentioned will be charged at the Mixed Hardwood Pulp price.

- 1) Bids must meet or exceed the total minimum acceptable bid of **<u>\$6,635.00</u>**.
- 2) Each species/product must be bid on (per ton or MBF).
- 3) A bid will be rejected if any individual species/product bid is \$0.
- 4) Cordwood weight conversion factors are as follows: Mixed Hardwood = 2.400 Aspen = 2.250

#### Paint Color Scheme:

• Orange: Sale/stand boundary and reserve/leave trees. Do not cut any orange marked trees.

#### Seasonal Restrictions:

• Harvesting operations are limited to frozen or dry/firm ground conditions.

#### Harvest Requirements:

- Contract ending date will be **June 30, 2025** (allowing approximately 2 seasons to complete).
- Harvest area is bounded by orange paint line.
- No machine operation allowed outside of orange paint line, or in adjacent wetland areas.
- No bond is required with bid on this timber sale. A performance bond of 15% of the total bid value will be required within 6 weeks of announcement of successful bidder.
- Sale will be mill scale using a 30-day billing period.
- Equipment must be cleaned and inspected by DNR staff before entering and leaving the sale area to prevent the introduction/spread of invasive species.

#### **Slash Requirements:**

• Do not pile slash within riparian or other wetland areas.

### **<u>Road/Trail Requirements:</u>**

- DOT approved signage is required to be placed on County Road N during harvest and hauling operations for safety reasons.
- Any non-frozen hauling will require approaches to be graveled (100 feet in length, 12 feet wide, 6 inches deep). US Forest Service will supply gravel from their pit.

### Additional Requirements:

- NO SALE MAY BEGIN WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION AND AN ON-SITE MEETING WITH A WISCONSIN DNR SALE ADMINISTRATOR.
- Keep all logging debris and machine operations within sale boundaries.
- Leave all standing snag and cull/den trees that do not pose a safety hazard. If needed to remove as a safety precaution, cut and leave lay on the ground.
- New temporary roads, stubs, or turn-arounds will need approval by the timber sale administrator and may require berms/slash.
- Temporary Roads shall have the road base constructed to a width of 12 feet or narrower, and with vegetative clearing of trees and brush not to exceed a width of 25 feet. Exceptions to the 12-foot maximum width of the road base may be granted by the sale administrator for operational reasons.
- If roads that are marked with **Proposed Berm** symbol are utilized, they must be closed with a logging debris berm. Do not dig a depression that will collect and hold water when constructing berms.
  - **Proposed Berm** shall be constructed using logging debris which includes any combination of dirt mixed with rocks, stumps, logs, root-wads, and/or slash.
  - **Proposed Berm** shall be constructed without creating a defined trench.
  - **Proposed Berm** shall be at least 4-5 feet in height from ground level.
- All road maintenance and post-harvest rehabilitation will be the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained upon request.
