## **Cutting Specifications**

Do not cut boundary trees marked with red or blue paint.

<u>Unit 1 –</u> Oak Seed Tree. 23 Acres. Cut all trees greater than 2" DBH within harvest boundary. Do not cut trees marked with green paint. No harvesting oak between the dates of April 1 and July 15.

<u>Unit 2 - Pine Thinning</u>. 19 Acres. Cut all trees marked with orange paint.

Unit 3 – Overstory Removal. 8 Acres. Cut all Jack pine greater than 5" DBH.

#### **Operational Considerations-**

- 1. Harvest during dry/ frozen ground only. Do not cut within 15 feet of various wetlands on site.
- 2. The harvest area boundary is marked in red to separate forest stands. Do not cut red-painted trees.
- 3. All pine products cut between March 1<sup>st</sup> and August 31<sup>st</sup> must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting to control bark beetle populations. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed before March 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. All roads and trails used by logging equipment and trucks should be restored to condition satisfactory to property manager.
- 5. Slash must be evenly lopped/scattered within the sale boundary and shall be deposited a minimum of 10 feet from the mowed right-of-way of any highway, town road, or recreational trail. Slash within 50 feet of all town roads and recreational trails must lie within 2 feet of the ground. Do not bury seedlings or saplings with slash.
- 6. The pine stands are located within the 25-mile Heterobasidian Root Disease (Annosum) area and require stump treatment unless harvested between December 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup>.

### **General Requirements:**

- 1. All landings must be approved by a DNR forester before operations begin.
- 2. All designated tree species must be cut and forwarded concurrently with the sale.
- 3. All stumps shall be no higher than the stump diameter, or 10 inches, whichever is less.
- 4. Utilization: cut and use all designated trees with one or more 100" sticks to a 4" top diameter.
- 5. Any new roads and all landings must be approved by a DNR forester before operations begin.
- 6. Any berms removed during contract period must be restored to the satisfaction of the DNR Forester.
- 7. Any trees cut or pushed over for roads or landings must be removed to the DNR Forester's satisfaction.
- 8. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Invasive Species applies contractor must clean equipment before entering and leaving the sale area! Brush away all dirt and clean air intakes of debris.
