

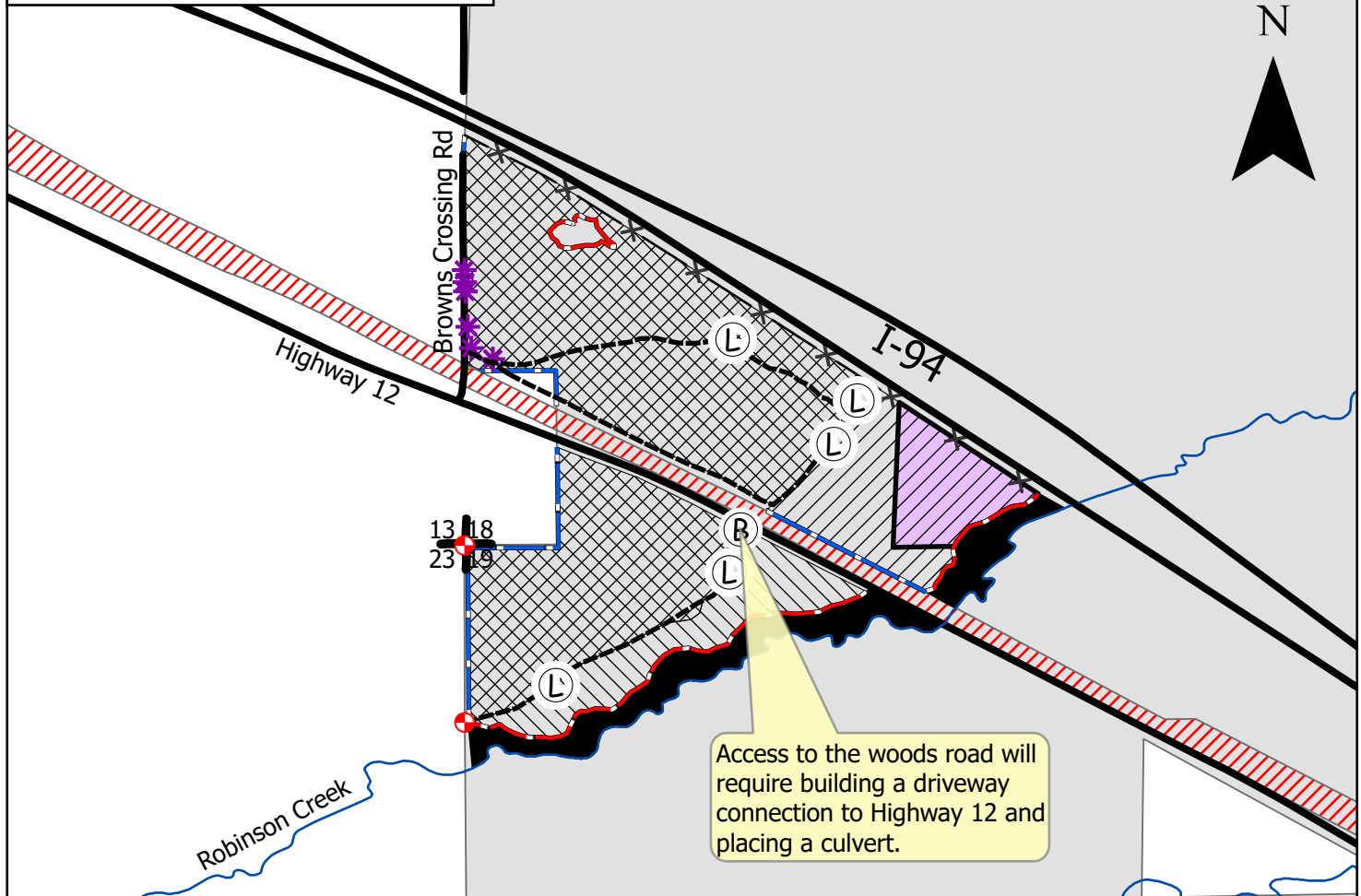

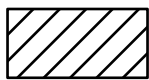

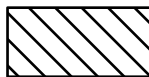
Robinson Creek Forest Production Area



HRD treatment of pine stumps required unless cut between Dec. 1 and March 31. There is endangered species habitat along the ROW of Browns Crossing Road, and the woods road. Work with the DNR forester to avoid ground disturbance.



Clearcut (25 acres) - Harvest all trees 2" DBH and larger.
Leave all standing dead snags.



Overstory Removal (17 acres) - Harvest all white pine that will make
>= 1 8' pulp stick. Harvest all other trees 2" DBH and larger.
Leave all standing dead snags.



Red Pine Thinning (104 acres) - cut all trees marked with orange paint.
