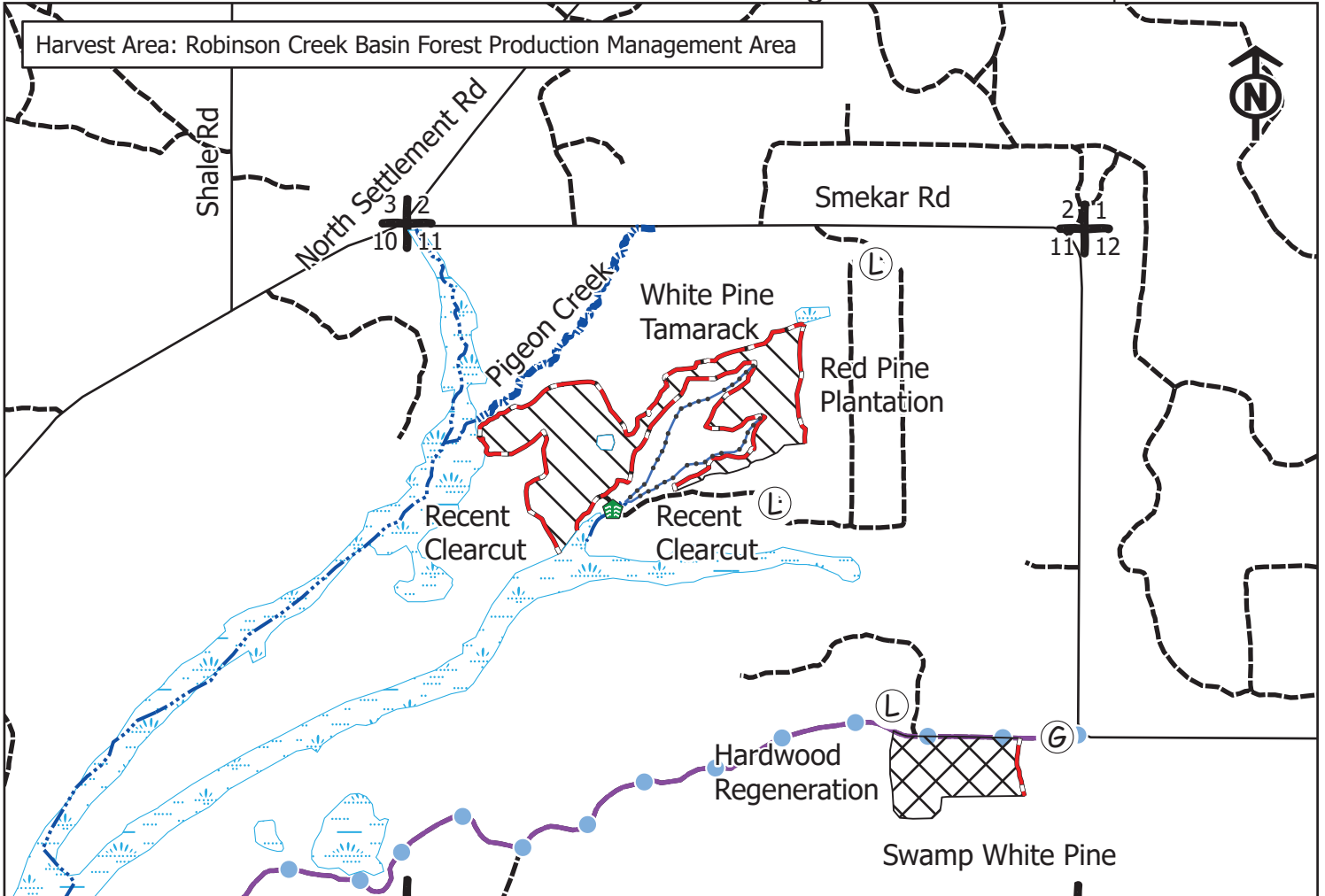


BLACK RIVER STATE FOREST

This sale will require stump treatment for HRD unless harvesting occurs between December 1 and March 31!

The contractor will be responsible for fixing any trail, gate, and sign damage that was caused by the contractor to the satisfaction of the parks staff.

32 Acre Regeneration Harvest: Cut all trees greater than 5" at DBH except leave 8-10 large crowned trees per acre (about 1 tree every 70 feet). It is important to protect advanced regeneration. Minimize slashing especially on the west end. This part of the sale will require dry conditions. And about 33% of it will require extreme drought conditions or frozen ground.



12 Acre White Pine Thinning: Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Due to rare species no harvesting allowed from April 30 - September 30.
