Special Operating Requirements and Slash Disposal:

1. *Trump Coulee Rearing Station is NOT part of a 3rd party certification program.* Timber harvested on this property is not considered a certified forest product.
2. **Shelterwood:** Harvest all trees 2" DBH and greater except for trees marked with purple paint and snags. **Overstory Removal:** Harvest all trees that will make an 8' pulp stick or more, expect snags. Avoid destroying regeneration as much as possible. **Coppice:** Harvest all trees 2" and greater, except snags.
3. The sale boundaries are red paint lines, blue paint lines and the Kennedy Road right-of-way.
4. **Oak Wilt Harvesting Restriction:** Harvest on this sale may not occur from April 1st to July 15th.
5. Slash must be evenly lopped/scattered within the sale boundary and shall be deposited a minimum of 10 feet from the property boundary and road right of way. Do not bury seedlings or saplings with slash.
6. Any access through private property is the responsibility of the purchaser.

General Requirements:

1. All designated tree species must be cut and forwarded concurrently.
2. Minimum top diameters are as follows: Pulpwood (Tons) – 4", and Oak Logs (MBF) – 10"
3. All stumps shall be no higher than the stump diameter, or 10 inches, whichever is less.
4. Do not cut or knock down any dead or hollow trees. These are important wildlife habitat. Any that must be cut shall be left in big pieces on the forest floor.
5. Notify the DNR Forester (Nick Urich 715-896-0536) before you start the job, and each time you pull out or return to the job.
6. Any new roads and all landings must be approved by a DNR forester before operations begin.
7. Any berms removed during harvesting operations must be put back to the satisfaction of the DNR Forester.
8. Any trees cut or pushed over for roads or landings must be utilized or cleaned up to the DNR Forester's satisfaction.
9. Contact the Town of Springfield at 715-662-2661 for information on hauling operations, and prior to hauling on town roads.
10. **Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Invasive Species applies – contractor must clean equipment before entering and leaving the sale area! This involves brushing away all dirt and cleaning air intakes of debris.**
