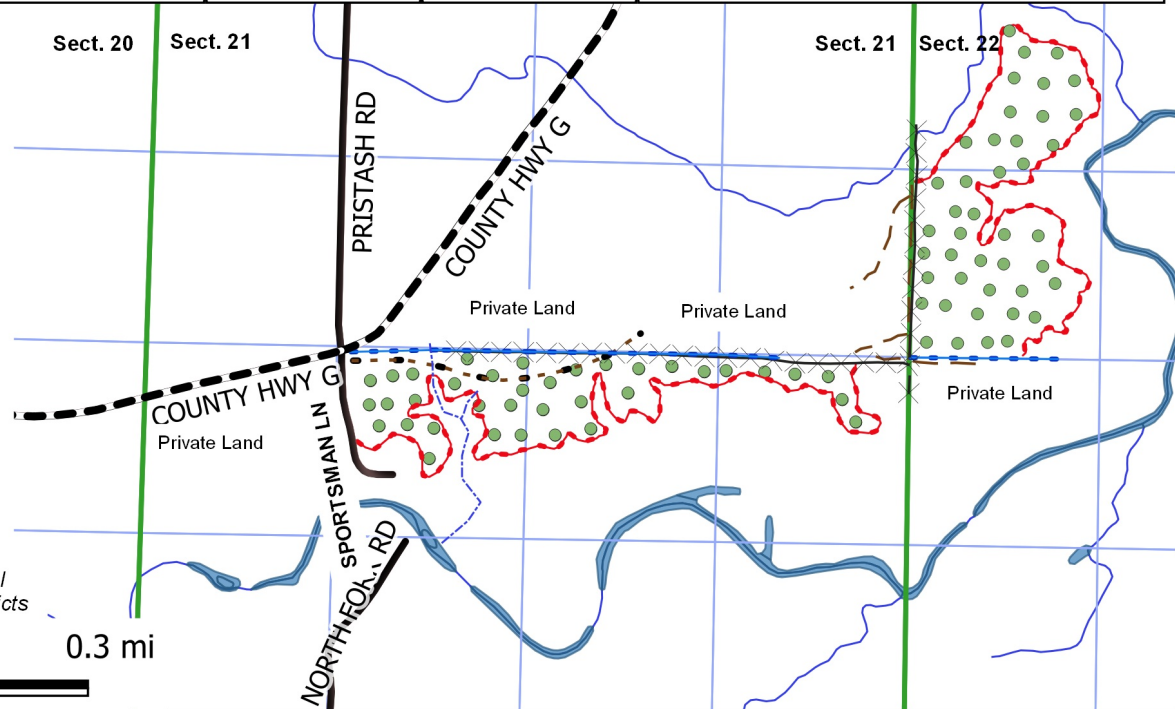

- This is a ticket sale. The sale will be sold by the ton.
- This is a frozen conditions only sale. If forest health concerns, such as oak wilt arise, or excessive damage occurs, additional time or harvest restrictions may be imposed.
- Access is from Sportsman Lane and private lands. Contractor must obtain access from neighboring private landowners in order to access eastern block of sale.
- Cut all trees 2" diameter and larger within the 78 marked gaps. No trees will be cut outside of gaps unless needed for operational reasons.
 - o Reserve all white pine, white spruce, red pine, hemlock, and cedar.
 - o Total harvest area approximately 20 acres, made up of 78 quarter acre gaps (approximately 120' in diameter).
 - o Perimeter marker trees painted with two green dots facing toward gap center. Cut within the gap.
 - o To assist in locating gap, marker trees also have one green slash on back facing outside of gap.
 - o Operational trees may be cut when moving between gaps, at sale administrator's discretion.
- Utilize to a minimum 4" top diameter.
- No whole tree/biomass harvest will be allowed
- Slash is to be scattered and cut to no more than 2' of the ground.
- Sale boundaries defined by red paint line, fence line, Sportsman Lane, and blue paint lines.
- Decking of wood along roads will not be allowed without permission from township and/or Bayfield County.
 - o Landing and decking areas to be confirmed at pre-sale meeting with forester and property manager.
- Comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Comply with Best Management Practices for Water Quality: Inform DNR within 30 days of needs for chapter 30 permits.
