
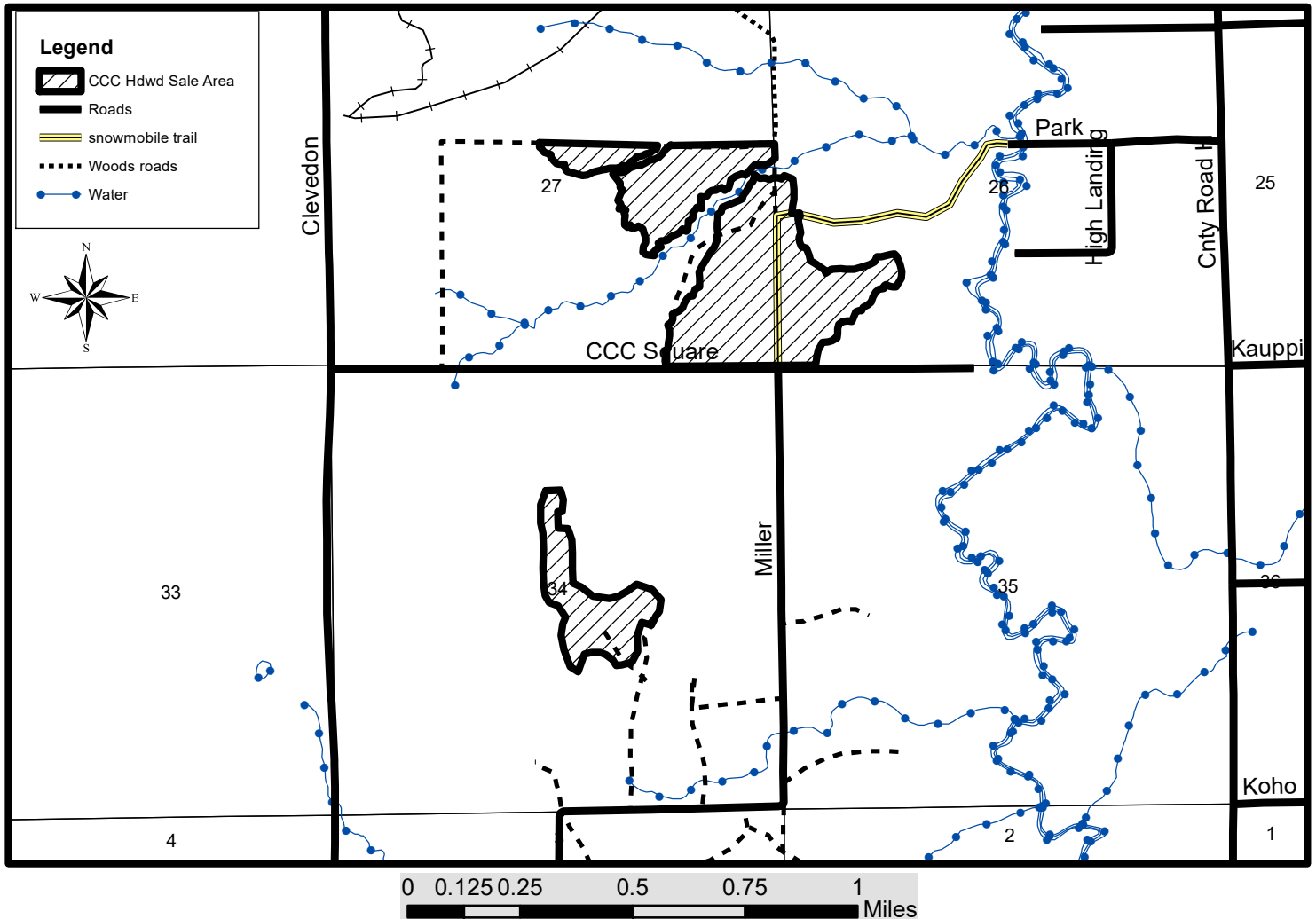

1. Sale boundaries marked in red paint or bounded by obvious roads.
2. **Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, basswood, ash, and fir that contain one or more 100 inch stick to a 4 inch top diameter.** Leave all trees marked in green paint. Dead snags not deemed to be dangerous shall be left uncut and undamaged. Any observed cavity trees shall be left uncut.
3. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4-inch top diameter. Slash height must not exceed three feet in depth nor longer than eight feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
4. Sale operations restricted to very dry or frozen conditions between the dates of August 10 through March 15.
4. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator. Snowmobile trail access to be left with snow cover and open for snowmobile use.
