

Harvest Specs:

In all units: Cut all stems 2" and larger except red pine, white pine, and any tree marked with green paint.

Restrictions:

1. Snowmobile trail may not be used when it is open for snowmobile season.
2. North Country Hiking Trail traverses sale area. The trail should be kept clear of slash and debris throughout sale operations. Limit equipment crossings over trail.
3. Sale Boundaries marked by red paint, blue paint, roads, or obvious type changes
4. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4" top diameter. Slash height must not exceed three feet in depth nor longer than 8 feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
5. From May 15 through August 15 all cut pine products must be hauled off site within 2 weeks of harvest to mitigate pine bark beetle concerns.
6. The east unit will require a small amount of new road if accessing through DNR land.
7. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator.
