

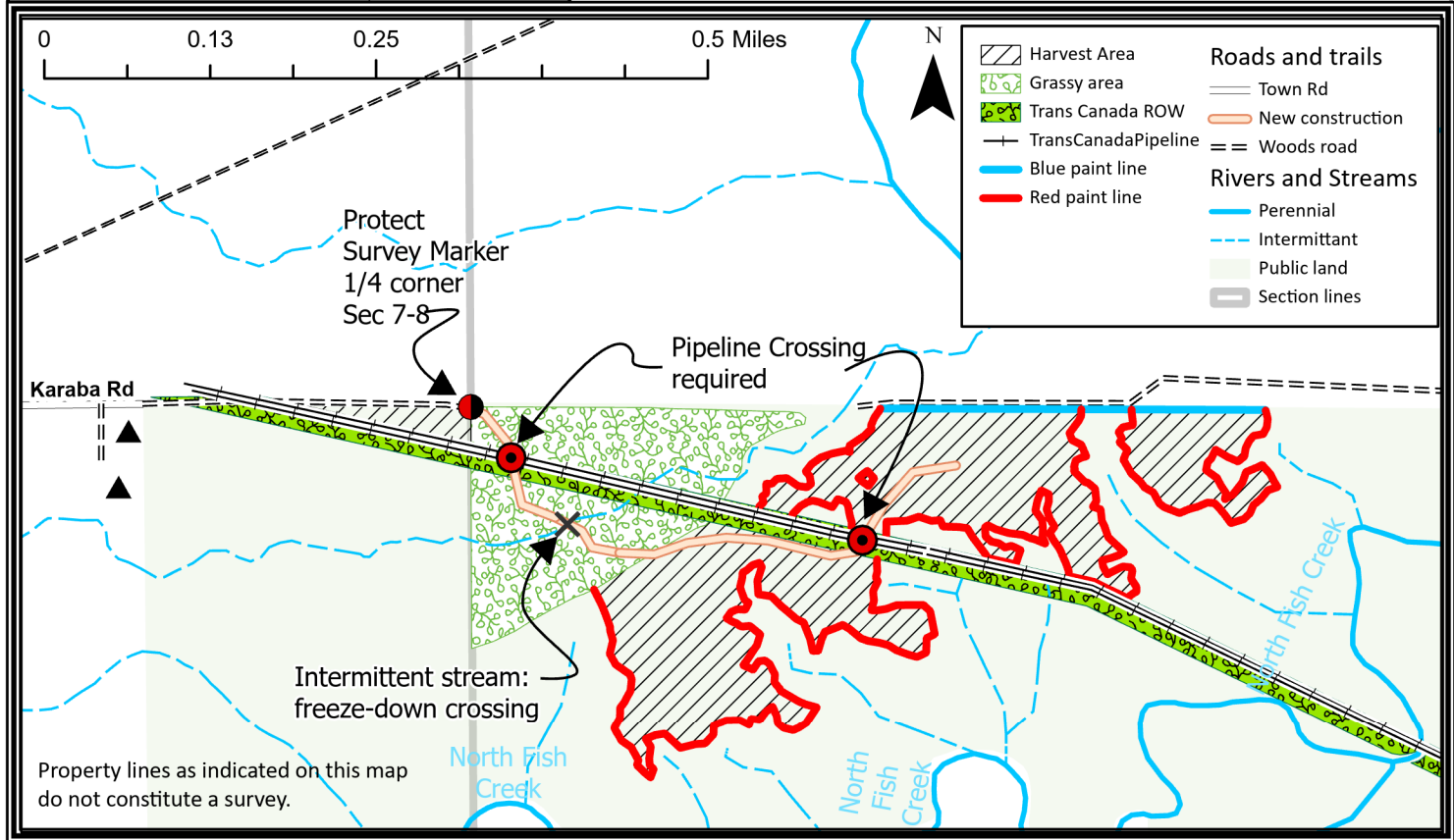

1) HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

- HARVEST all trees 6 inches in diameter and larger, and merchandise all wood to a 5" top, EXCEPT:
- DO NOT HARVEST OR DAMAGE red oak, hemlock, red pine, white pine, yellow birch, balsam fir, and white cedar (approximately 13 sq.ft./acre basal area residual.)
- Leave all snags unless they pose a safety hazard to logging operations.

2) OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS and SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- The sale shall be harvested in frozen season only, as determined by the timber sale administrator.
- Sale boundaries are the blue-painted private property line, red paint lines, Karaba Rd, and grassy areas as shown on map.
- Tops must be scattered throughout the sale and may not be left on landings.

3) ACCESS AND ROADS:

- Contractor will work with TransCanada to safely cross the pipeline in two places as indicated on map. Approval will be required by TransCanada and Timber Sale Administrator. TransCanada has indicated timber mats or similar clear-span structures will be needed.
- Intermittent stream crossing exists on main haul road. Cross with a pole ford, timber mats, or frozen snow bridge. Remove any structures before spring breakup.
- This contract requires authorization from the timber sale administrator for all road/landing construction. Roads, skid trails, and landings must be closed when sale is finished.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from the timber sale administrator.

4) OTHER:

- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Do not damage survey monumentation.
