

Harvest Specs:

Cut all aspen that contain one or more 100 inch sticks to a 4 inch top diameter. Leave all other trees uncut and undamaged. Any observed snag or cavity tree shall be left uncut unless it poses a safety hazard.

Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100 inch stick to a 4 inch top diameter.

Restrictions:

1. Sale is restricted to **short wood logging only**.
2. All boundaries are marked with red paint or bounded by roads and trails.
3. Sale operations are restricted to **dry conditions between the dates of July 15 and December 1 for oak wilt avoidance and ski trail use**. No more than 30 cords may be decked over winter.
4. **Recreational trails are found throughout area. Trails may be used for forwarding if leveled and graded to original specs before closeout. Trail crossings, landings and turnarounds should be minimal and must be approved by sale administrator.**
5. Slash height must not exceed two feet in depth nor longer than eight feet in length and spread evenly over site. Slash must be pulled back 15 feet from all trails.
