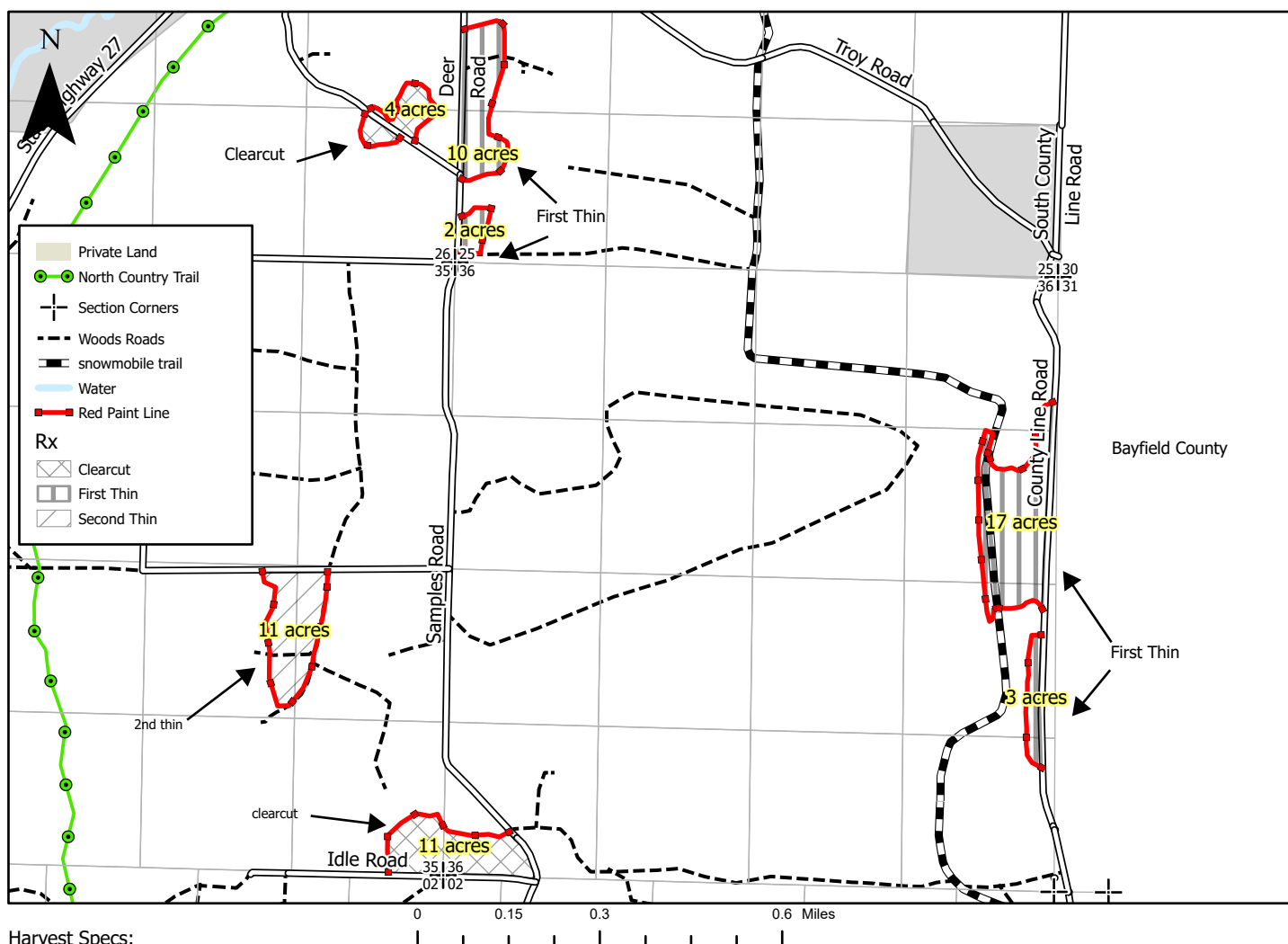

Harvest Specs:

- **2nd Thinning:** Cut all aspen, jack pine, and all trees marked in orange paint.
- **Clearcut:** Cut all trees 2 DBH and larger not marked in green paint.
- **1st thinning:** Cut all jack pine and every 3rd red pine row.

Restrictions:

1. Sale Boundaries marked by red paint, roads, or obvious type changes.
2. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4" top diameter. Slash height must not exceed two feet in depth nor longer than 8 feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
3. Slash must be pulled back 15' from all roads and trails.
4. Snowmobile trail must not be used for hauling when it is open for the snowmobile season.
5. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator.

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
