

- 2nd Thinning: Cut all aspen, jack pine, and all trees marked in orange paint.
- Clearcut: Cut all trees 2 DBH and larger not marked in green paint.
- 1st thinning: Cut all jack pine and every 3rd red pine row.

Restrictions:

- 1. Sale Boundaries marked by red paint, roads, or obvious type changes.
- 2. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4" top diameter. Slash height must not exceed two feet in depth nor longer than 8 feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
- 3. Slash must be pulled back 15' from all roads and trails.
- 4. Snowmobile trail must not be used for hauling when it is open for the snowmobile season.
- 5. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator.

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
