

Harvest Specs:

• **Third Thinning Area:** Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Cut all jack pine and aspen that contain one or more 100" sticks.

• **First Thinning Area:** Harvest every third row. Some rows are indistinct. Access rows should be cleared to a width not wider than 15 feet between trees.

Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100-inch stick to a minimum 4-inch top diameter.

Restrictions:

1. **Grassy opening along Hwy S shall not be used for decking. Deck along woods roads.**
2. Snowmobile trail may not be used when it is open for snowmobile traffic.
3. Slash should be cut to within two feet of the ground in segments not longer than eight feet. Slash must be pulled back 15 feet from all roads and trails.
4. Sale boundaries marked in red paint or bounded by roads.
5. New road or landing construction must be approved by Property Manager or Contract Administrator.
