BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales
 - a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
 - c. The **high bidder** will be determined by the **greatest total bid** for each tract.
 - d. Bids will be opened in random order.
 - e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name,

address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.

2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
3. Submit each bid in an **individual sealed envelope** marked “Bid for Timber Stumpage” with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus
4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No “zero- \$0.00” bids for any species or products will be accepted and bid will be rejected.
5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and **must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening.** If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
6. A **Performance Bond or Letter of Credit** is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Performance bonds in a form of other than cash for these sales must expire no earlier than **1-year past contract expiration date.**
7. For sales requiring pesticide applications (e.g. HRD treatment). The Purchaser shall ensure and provide documentation that any person(s) who applies or handles any pesticide on Department lands is covered by a valid Pesticide Business License, Individual Commercial Applicators License, and Forestry 2.0 Certification issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) prior to pesticide application.
The cost of this application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions, but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales.
8. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A [Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate](#) must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. UTILIZATION

1. See individual timber sales for utilization specifications.

SCALING AND PAYMENT

1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.

5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square with at least 1 cord(s) per pile or 0.5 MBF. At least 1 cord(s) or 0.5 MBF will be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.
6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species pro-rates/conversions.

CONTRACT PERIOD

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening will expire **June 30, 2027**, unless noted on individual timber sale map.

CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract expiration dates are given on the individual timber sale. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

Three and Four-year Contracts

- 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

OTHER CONDITIONS

Contractor claiming exemption, independent status, the contractor/purchaser will be required to submit a signed, notarized affidavit that affirms their exempt status pursuant to the criteria listed in section 102.07(7)(b), of the Wisconsin Statutes.

CUTTING AREA DESCRIPTION: The timber sale cutting unit is bound by vertical Red lines surrounding three sides of the sale. 4th street, commonly known as Finley Road is the southern border for the sale. Cutting shall take place within the vertical Red lines in all stands and shall not extend past marked trees on any portion of the stands or extend south of 4th Street.

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS:

- Within the harvest area, **cut all Red and White Pine marked in Orange paint. Cut all Oak, Aspen, and Red Maple trees greater than 1” in diameter.** Do not cut trees with Red Vertical Lines or those marked with Green or purple paint.
- **Harvest operations allowed within the sale area from November 11th through March 14th, due to endangered species habitat within the sale area.**
- Blowdown Oak may be salvaged.
- No decking of wood on either side of 4th St. due to public safety and environmental concerns.
- Biomass (woody material under the stated merchantability standard listed above.) harvesting is **not** permitted.
- Pine products must be hauled within 3 weeks of cutting from March 1st through August 31st to prevent the build-up of Bark Beetles.
- Utilize all cut trees to a 4” top diameter.
- HRD restriction: **All pine stumps must be treated with an HRD preventative (RotstopC or Cellu-Treat) from 4/1 - 11/30 within 24 hours of harvest.**

ACCESS: There is a two-track road on the West end of 4th street. The trail runs North, and most portions of the sale are accessible from the trail. Contractor will be responsible for maintenance and /or upgrades for truck traffic into the sale area. Truck turn-around areas may need to be constructed within the sale area. All roads must be returned to as-is or better condition at the end of the contract period. Contact the property forester for further details.

- No whole tree skidding, products must be felled and merchandized at the stump, then hauled out of the woods to protect leave trees.



All pine marked with orange paint are to be cut, as well as every other species with at least one 100” pulp stick unless marked in green paint. This sale is all-season ground and may be cut year-round.






Survivorman Timber Sale Map




