## **BIDDING REQUIREMENTS**

### **1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales**

- Bids will be made by species for each tract.
- Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
- The high bidder will be determined by the greatest total bid for each tract.
- Bids will be opened in random order.

- e. Bidders in attendance can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.

2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.

3. Submit each bid in an individual sealed envelope marked “Bid for Timber Stumpage” with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus.

4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No “zero- \$0.00” bids for any species or products will be accepted and bid will be rejected.

5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.

6. A Performance Bond or Letter of Credit is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Performance bonds in a form of other than cash for these sales must expire no earlier than 1-year past contract expiration date.

7. For sales requiring pesticide applications (e.g. HRD treatment), the Purchaser shall ensure and provide documentation that any person(s) who applies or handles any pesticide on Department lands is covered by a valid Pesticide Business License, Individual Commercial Applicators License, and Forestry 2.0 Certification issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) prior to pesticide application.

The cost of this application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions, but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales.

8. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

## SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. ## UTILIZATION

1. All trees designated for cutting will be utilized to a 6" top, unless stated otherwise in the prospectus.
2. When designated for cutting, all trees containing one (1) or more one hundred inch (100") long stick to a six inch (6") minimum top diameter will be considered merchantable.

## SCALING AND PAYMENT

1. Sales are sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
2. If needed, the mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
3. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
4. If needed, Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
5. If needed, weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species pro-rates/conversions.

## CONTRACT PERIOD

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening have expiration dates stated clearly on the prospectus for each sale.

## CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract expiration dates are given on the individual timber sale. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

### One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

### Three and Four-year Contracts

- 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

## OTHER CONDITIONS

1. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Water Quality, Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines, and Best Management Practices for Invasive Species must be followed on all DNR timber sales. More information on these management guidelines can be found at the links found below:

2. HRD/Oak Wilt requirements. See language in prospectus for each sale.
3. Off-road logging equipment shall be free of concentrations of plant material and soil prior to entering the sale area. The Purchaser will contact the Seller 48 hours prior to delivering equipment to the sale area to arrange for on-site inspection. No equipment dropped off without 48hr notice to DNR Forester.

## **Insurance**

The “Contractor” (purchaser) shall provide the Department of Natural Resources with a Certificate of Insurance counter-signed by a Wisconsin Resident Agent, indicating that Worker’s Compensation Insurance coverage is provided for the duration of the contract prior to any performance under it. Contractor claiming exemption, independent status, the contractor/purchaser will be required to submit a signed, notarized affidavit that affirms their exempt status pursuant to the criteria listed in section 102.07(7)(b), of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Contract may contain other provisions. Contracts may not be assigned. A sample copy of the contract is available upon request.

**Unit 1-** (28ac) Oak & White pine regeneration harvest. Cut all trees 1.0" dbh & larger except for those trees marked in green, red, purple or blue paint on the stem & the stump.

**Unit 2-** (11ac) Red pine plantation thinning. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint on the stem & the stump. Additionally, all aspen is designated for harvest.

**Operational Considerations-**

- Pre-harvest meeting on site prior to any snowfall and prior to any equipment moving in. No equipment allowed on site prior to discussion/meeting with timber sale administrator on such matter. **No exceptions.**
- Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD) – The Purchaser shall purchase and apply an approved fungicide (Rotstop C or Cellu-Treat) to all cut pine stumps and horizontal wound surfaces as is noted in the timber sale contract.
- Off-road logging equipment shall be free of concentrations of plant material and soil prior to entering the sale area. The Purchaser will contact the Seller 48 hours prior to delivering equipment to the sale area to arrange for on-site inspection. No equipment dropped off without 48hr notice to timber sale administrator.
- Orange polygon on timber sale map is a prairie and shall not be used/crossed by any timber sale equipment for any reason unless approved by timber sale administrator.
- Utilization of all products to at least 6".
- Between May 1 and September 15, all cut conifer products must be removed from the sale area within two weeks after being cut.
- Access is off 1<sup>st</sup> Ave, via an easement across private land.

- The locations, building, and maintenance of new landings, roads, and accesses are the full responsibility of the purchaser and are always subject to advance approval and under the conditions of the timber sale administrator who must be contacted at least 48 hours prior to construction of a landing, road, or access.
- Roads, skid trails and landings shall be graded and leveled or closed out to the satisfaction of the Seller/timber sale administrator upon completion of timber sales. Any accesses developed across ditches or other drainage features will be restored to their original condition.
- Existing skid trails must be kept free of debris and ruts. They must be left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions during mid-contract “pull-off” or end of sale.
- Rutting will be monitored and if soil disturbances become excessive (based on established thresholds defined in contract), harvesting operations may be suspended until the affected areas are repaired properly.
- No full tree length skidding will be allowed. All products to be removed on a forwarder, no ground skidding will be allowed. All cut stringers must be utilized.
- Do not cut standing dead trees unless they pose an operational hazard.
- Follow Wisconsin BMP’s for water quality at all times. Avoid wetlands as much as possible and only operate within them during very dry times with timber matting or under frozen ground conditions.
- Slash shall be scattered evenly across sale area but not have a height restriction.

**Unit 1-** (38ac) Oak & Mx Hardwood regeneration/salvage harvest. Cut all trees 1.0" dbh & larger except for those trees marked in green, red, purple or blue paint on the stem & the stump.

**Unit 2-** (82ac) Pine plantation thinning and oak/mx hdwd thinning. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint on the stem & the stump. Harvesting in oak/mx hdwd areas from July 16<sup>th</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup> which is outside of Oak Wilt Restrictions. Additionally, all aspen and ash are designated for harvest.



- Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD) – The Purchaser shall purchase and apply an approved fungicide (Rotstop C or Cellu-Treat) to all cut pine stumps and horizontal wound surfaces as is noted in the timber sale contract.
- MX Hardwood volumes include 150T ash pulp, 122T basswood pulp & 20MBF basswood.
- Off-road logging equipment shall be free of concentrations of plant material and soil prior to entering the sale area. The Purchaser will contact the Seller 48 hours prior to delivering equipment to the sale area to arrange for on-site inspection. No equipment dropped off without 48hr notice to DNR Forester.
- No harvesting during the traditional nine day deer gun season.

- All products harvested to a 6" minimum top.
- Public access is off 1<sup>st</sup> Ave and ST HWY 22.
- Any access through private lands must be secured by the contractor. Landowner south of sale may consider this.
- Between May 1 and September 15, all cut conifer products must be removed from the sale area within two weeks after being cut.
- The locations, building, and maintenance of new landings, roads, and accesses are the full responsibility of the purchaser and are always subject to advance approval and under the conditions of the timber sale administrator who must be contacted at least 48 hours prior to construction of a landing, road, or access.

Some areas of this sale will likely require frozen ground conditions due to access across wetlands. WI DNR may have some timber mats available to use.



**Unit 2-** (18ac) Harvest all trees marked with orange paint on the stem & the stump. Additionally, all aspen, ash and balsam are designated for harvest.


