BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales
 - a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
 - c. The <u>high bidder</u> will be determined by the <u>greatest total bid</u> for each tract.
 - d. Bids will be opened in random order.
 - e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.



- 2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
- 3. Submit each bid in an **individual sealed envelope** marked "Bid for Timber Stumpage" with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus.
- 4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No "zero-\$0.00" bids for any species or products will be accepted and bid will be rejected.
- 5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
- 6. A <u>Performance Bond or Letter of Credit</u> is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Contents of an irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) or Assurance/Surety bonds must include the following:
 - a. Letter of Credit number.
 - b. Timber sale identification property name and sale or tract number.
 - c. A clear statement that it is irrevocable.
 - d. Name of the bank's customer; that is the principal.
 - e. Amount of credit extended (maximum limit). This limit must equal or exceed the penal sum or penalty for which the letter of credit is pledged to secure.
 - f. An authorization to draw sight drafts upon the bank in favor of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
 - g. A clear statement that the letter of credit number appearing on a sight draft is sufficient identification for honoring it. The letter must specify only one identification number.
 - h. Expiration of bond: The expiration date must be 1 year beyond the contract expiration date
- 7. For sales requiring pesticide applications (e.g. HRD treatment). The Purchaser shall ensure and provide documentation that any person(s) who applies or handles any pesticide on Department lands is covered by a valid Pesticide Business License, Individual Commercial Applicators License, and Forestry 2.0 Certification issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) prior to pesticide application.
 - The cost of this application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions, but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales.
- 8. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A <u>Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate</u> must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. UTILIZATION

1. See individual timber sales for utilization specifications.

SCALING AND PAYMENT

- 1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
- 2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
- 3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
- 4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
- 5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square. Size of piles will be at the discretion of the DNR Forester for the property. DNR Forester will also determine minimum size to be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.
- 6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
- 7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
- 8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species prorates/conversions.

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening will expire December 31st, 2028 unless noted on individual timber sale map.

CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

Three and Four-year Contracts

• 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

OTHER CONDITIONS

1. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Water Quality, Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines, and Best Management Practices for Invasive Species must be followed on all DNR timber sales.

SPECIFIC CUTTING REQUIREMENTS:

- An on-site meeting is required prior to any harvesting to discuss operational concerns.
- Cutting and skidding must take place between November 1st and March 30th.
- Frozen ground <u>NOT</u> required, but ground must be dry to limit rutting.
- Unmarked tree species "designated for harvest" throughout entire sale area include: aspen, boxelder, black locust, and ironwood.
- General Sale Area/Conifer Stand: Harvest all and only trees marked with an orange slash and tree species "designated for harvest" within the sale boundary.
- **Black Locust Stand:** This area is designated by a marked purple boundary. Harvest all and only species listed as "designated for harvest" or trees marked with an orange slash in this area. All stumps in this area left from harvested trees must be treated with herbicide within 1 hour after cut. Herbicides to be used will be agreed upon by a DNR Forester and the contractor.
- Timber sale boundaries are established at paved roads and trees marked with a red paint. There are no boundaries with other ownerships than the State of Wisconsin. No boundary trees are to be harvested.
- The paint on trees has started to fade from the original marking, but the trees will be re-marked by DNR Forester upon sale of timber.
- Utilize sawlog size trees to a 10" top and pulpwood to a 4" top (diameter inside bark).
- All slash shall be lopped and/or scattered to lie within four feet of the ground; slash must also be removed from all public access trails, field, parking lot and roads. Slash shall be removed from these areas so that it does not lie on



OR protrude into the trail zone. Slash that falls in these areas must be removed immediately. This is to be done concurrent with the cutting operation.

- Any standing dead snags, are to be left if they do not pose a hazard to logging contractors.
- Residual tress shall not be excessively damaged. Residual damage will not be tolerated and excessive damage to residual trees will be subject to penalty.
- Haul roads, skid trails, and landings must be approved by local DNR Forester and must conform to DNR Best Management Practices.
- Contractor must utilize signage designating timber harvesting areas near trails.
- Contractor must utilize signage on roads near landings where loading and hauling will take place.
- DNR staff will work to close down and/or re-route trails in active sale areas.
- Walking trails must be avoided by heavy equipment and may only be used to cross over when necessary. Using trails for any skidding or access may be approved by DNR Forester or Property Manager.

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

- Mill scale, weight or measured, shall be used for pulpwood and sawtimber. The ticket system will be utilized for all wood hauled. If wood is being hauled to a purchaser that cannot or will not return a scale slip to this Forest, then the wood must be scaled by the Forest representative before being hauled. Deferred payment for stumpage is allowed on this sale unless successful bidder is on the advance pay list.
- Contract length will allow for 3 full winters to cut and may not be sub-contracted or assigned.
- A copy of state contract available upon request; contract may contain additional provisions.
- Logging roads, skid trails and landings_must be approved, graded smooth, and seeded at completion and will be restricted to the harvest area whenever possible.
- The Purchaser agrees to take all steps and precautions to avoid and minimize soil disturbances, such as soil compaction and rutting. If soil disturbances occur, the Purchaser agrees to work cooperatively to mitigate and repair any and all instances of soil disturbance. Rutting must not be more than 6 inches deep.
- Avoid operating equipment in low areas as much as possible, especially near any permanent ponds or ephemeral ponds.
- Upon arrival on site, logging equipment shall be clean of soil or debris from other sites to minimize the chance for introduction of exotic plants.
- The volume offered for sale is estimated but not guaranteed. If there is less timber than estimated, there is no obligation of the DNR to make up the "shortage".



Cutting Specifications:

- Conifer Thinning (115 acres): Cut all trees marked on bole and stump with orange paint.
- Clearcut (11 acres): Cut all red pine, white pine, and spruce.
- All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch stick will be cut and utilized to a 4" top diameter.
- Sale bounded by natural stand changes from conifer to hardwoods. In certain areas Orange Chevrons designate boundary between conifer thinning and clearcut as well as Red Paint lines designate sale boundary. Do not harvest trees marked with red paint. (See map for boundary details)

Restrictions:

- Do not harvest trees, drop slash, or operate equipment across boundaries or on recreational trails. Along recreational trail, designated crossing point will be discussed ahead of time and must be approved by Wisconsin DNR timber sale administer overseeing the sale. Do not drop trees over the trail and remove any slash or debris from trail as soon as possible.
- All slash shall be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back from recreational trails a minimum of 10'.



- In winter only areas, no operations may take place without frozen ground conditions. Soil disturbance will not be tolerated. (See map for area locations)
- In all other areas you may operate from August 20th May 25th.

Operational Considerations:

- No sale may begin without prior notice and an on-site meeting with a Wisconsin DNR sale administrator.
- In all Stands Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD) Prevention Treatment:
 - The Purchaser shall purchase and apply an approved fungicide (Rotstop C or Cellu-Treat) to all cut pine stumps and horizontal wound surfaces as follows:
 - o Pesticide applicators must be certified/licensed by DATCP for this treatment.
 - All stumps shall be treated by the end of each day of cutting from April 1 November 30.
 - Treatment may be required from December 1 March 31 if abnormally warm for an extended period to be determined by DNR Forester.
 - All stumps shall be left clear of logging slash to allow for the application and inspection of the approved fungicide.
 - o A marker dye shall be added to the solution to monitor application coverage.
 - o Extra care must be done to minimize damage to residual trees.
 - o If Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD) is discovered prior to the completion of this harvest, a harvest protocol of infected area(s) shall be established, and all harvesting equipment must be cleaned of soil prior to leaving this harvest.
- Hauling is prohibited on the ATV/Snowmobile Trails on, weekends starting noon on Friday, through midnight Sunday, Federal Holidays, and between Christmas Day and New Year's Day. At all times during the snowmobile season, keep at least 1" of packed snow on the trail. Keep trail clearing (10' from the edge of the trail) cleared of debris resulting from purchaser's operations as work progresses. Do not deck wood on inside curves, where it could obscure oncoming traffic.
- Any standing dead snags are to be left if they do not pose a hazard to logging contractors.
- Soil rutting and damage to residual trees will not be tolerated.
- Haul roads, skid trails, and landings must be approved by local DNR Forester
- Off-road logging equipment shall be free of concentrations of plant material and soil prior to entering the sale area. The Purchaser will contact the Seller 48 hours prior to delivering equipment to the sale area to arrange for on-site inspection.
