BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales

- a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
 - c. The **high bidder** will be determined by the **greatest total bid** for each tract.
- d. Bids will be opened in random order.
- e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.
2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
3. **Submit each bid in an individual sealed envelope marked “Bid for Timber Stumpage” with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside.** Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus.
4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No “zero- \$0.00” bids for any species or products will be accepted and bid will be rejected.
5. **Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening.** If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
6. A **Performance Bond or Letter of Credit** is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Contents of an irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) or Assurance/Surety bonds must include the following:
 - a. Letter of Credit number.
 - b. Timber sale identification – property name and sale or tract number.
 - c. A clear statement that it is irrevocable.
 - d. Name of the bank's customer; that is the principal.
 - e. Amount of credit extended (maximum limit). This limit must equal or exceed the penal sum or penalty for which the letter of credit is pledged to secure.
 - f. An authorization to draw sight drafts upon the bank in favor of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
 - g. A clear statement that the letter of credit number appearing on a sight draft is sufficient identification for honoring it. The letter must specify only one identification number.
 - h. Expiration of bond: **The expiration date must be 1 year beyond the contract expiration date**
7. For sales requiring pesticide applications (e.g. HRD treatment). The Purchaser shall ensure and provide documentation that any person(s) who applies or handles any pesticide on Department lands is covered by a valid Pesticide Business License, Individual Commercial Applicators License, and Forestry 2.0 Certification issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) prior to pesticide application.

The cost of this application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions, but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales.

8. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A [Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate](https://www.revenue.wi.gov/DORForms/s-211-inst.pdf) must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. UTILIZATION

1. See individual timber sales for utilization specifications

SCALING AND PAYMENT

1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square with at least XX cords per pile or XX MBF. At least XX cords or XX MBF will be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.
6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species pro-rates/conversions.

CONTRACT PERIOD

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening will expire on **June 30, 2029** except for the Spencer School Forest sale which is **June 30, 2028**.

CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

Three and Four-year Contracts

- 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

OTHER CONDITIONS

1. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Water Quality, Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines, and Best Management Practices for Invasive Species must be followed on all DNR timber sales. Access:

Access to this timber sale is directly off the DNR Parking off Blueberry Lane. An access road can be used to access the south end of the timber sale. A woods road bisects the sale area.

Cutting Specifications:

- **Sale Area (10 acres):** Cut all trees greater than 2" in diameter within the sale area boundaries except for oak 18 inches and greater. Leave all conifer species.
- Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Non-merchantable trees must be cut concurrent with merchantable trees. Whole tree harvesting will not be permitted in this sale.
- Sawlog top diameter minimum of 10 inches. Pulpwood top diameter minimum of 4 inches.

Operational Considerations:

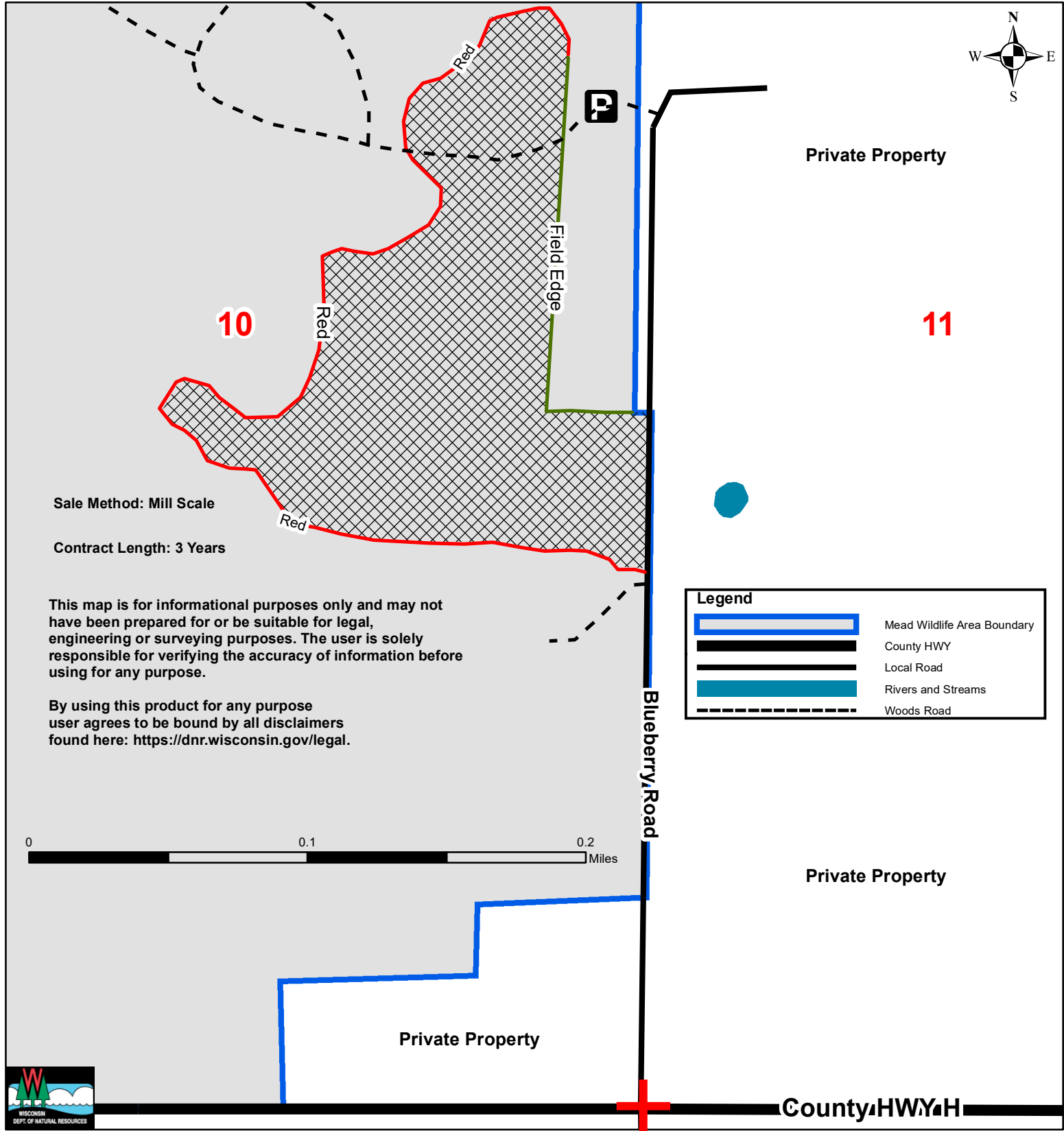

- Harvesting during frozen ground conditions only. No harvesting during the 9 day gun-deer season.
- New landings and roads must be approved by the DNR Forester.
- Do not cut any oak 18 inches and greater.

- Prompt and proper treatment of slash where required. It is the responsibility of the timber contractor to spread all slash evenly throughout the sale down to 2 ft. No slash on trails, landings, or private property.

Access:

- Access to the sale can be found in multiple places. The west side of the sale (Area 1) can be accessed off Engle Lane. The east side of the sale (Area 2) can be accessed either off Fisher Lane or Cottonwood Lane. Additionally, CTY C can be used to for access via a DNR woods road. Area 1 landing will be interior of cutting area via DNR woods road. Area 2 landing will be the field edge to the west of cutting area.

Cutting Specifications:

- **Coppice (92 acres):** Cut all trees greater than 2" in diameter within the sale area except for conifer species. No harvesting or equipment entry within the retention islands.
- **Selection (71 acres):** Cut all trees marked with orange paint within the red paint boundaries. Cut all trees greater than 1" in diameter within the purple paint boundaries, including purple marked trees. Cut all ironwood and musclewood.
- Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Non-merchantable trees must be cut concurrent with merchantable trees. Whole tree harvesting will not be permitted in this sale.
- Sawlog top diameter minimum of 10". Pulpwood top diameter minimum of 4".

Operational Considerations:

- Roads, trails, and landings utilized during the timber sale must be returned to original condition.
- "Logging Operations Ahead" or similar signs may be placed at all agreed upon access points on the sale area perimeter and visible throughout the duration of the sale.
- No harvesting during the 9-day gun deer season.
- Frozen ground conditions only as determined by the administering DNR Forester – a requirement for harvest.
- New landings and roads must be approved by administering DNR Forester.
- Snags, dead, or hazard trees are only to be cut if they present a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
- Snags and dead trees cut for safety reasons must be left in the harvest area and may not be utilized.
- Equipment must be clean and free of debris prior to entering the sale.

- No slash on trails, landings, roads, or flowages.

Cutting Specifications

Coppice (42 acres): Cut all trees greater than 1" in diameter within the stand except red, white, and jack pine, white birch under 5" and oak. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation. East unit must be cut first. A temporary frozen road must be used to access east unit. 2 areas flagged of approximately 30'x30' to be scraped clean to mineral soil within the east unit.

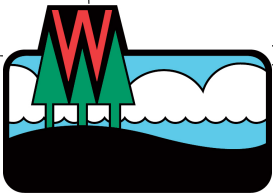
Operational Considerations-

- Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Non-merchantable trees must be cut concurrently with merchantable trees. Whole tree harvesting will not be permitted in this sale.
- No harvest or entry within green retention areas or yellow riparian management zone.
- Sawlog top diameter minimum of 10". Pulpwood top diameter minimum of 4".
