Special Contract Conditions:

- 1. Operations allowed July 15th through April 15th.
- 2. No new roads are allowed. Landings/decking areas will be located within the timber sale boundary. Roads/landings shall be graded and level to the satisfaction of the Department upon completion of the sale.
- 3. Access to the sale area is 1 mile west of Dry Landing Rd. off of an existing trail as indicated on the map.
- 4. During wet periods of the year the soils may become soft and susceptible to damage. Operations will be suspended during these periods.
- 5. WI BMP's for Water Quality must be followed. No equipment within 15 ft. of wetland edges.
- 6. Leave as many standing snags as possible as long as they do not compromise safety.
- 7. Slash shall be lopped and scattered to within 3' of the ground throughout the sale area.
- 8. Utilization to a 4" top DIB. No whole tree harvesting allowed. Pole skidding is allowed as long as damage to residual trees does not occur.
- 9. Maximum stump height shall be 10 inches or equal to the maximum stump diameter, whichever is less.
- 10. Damage to residual trees will result in additional skidding restrictions. Operations will be stopped, if in the opinion of the forester, unnecessary damage occurs.
- 11. All wood cut or in piles shall be removed within 30 days.
- 12. Do not harvest red or blue marked trees. No equipment is allowed across the blue paint line onto Burnett County Forest land at any time without permission.




