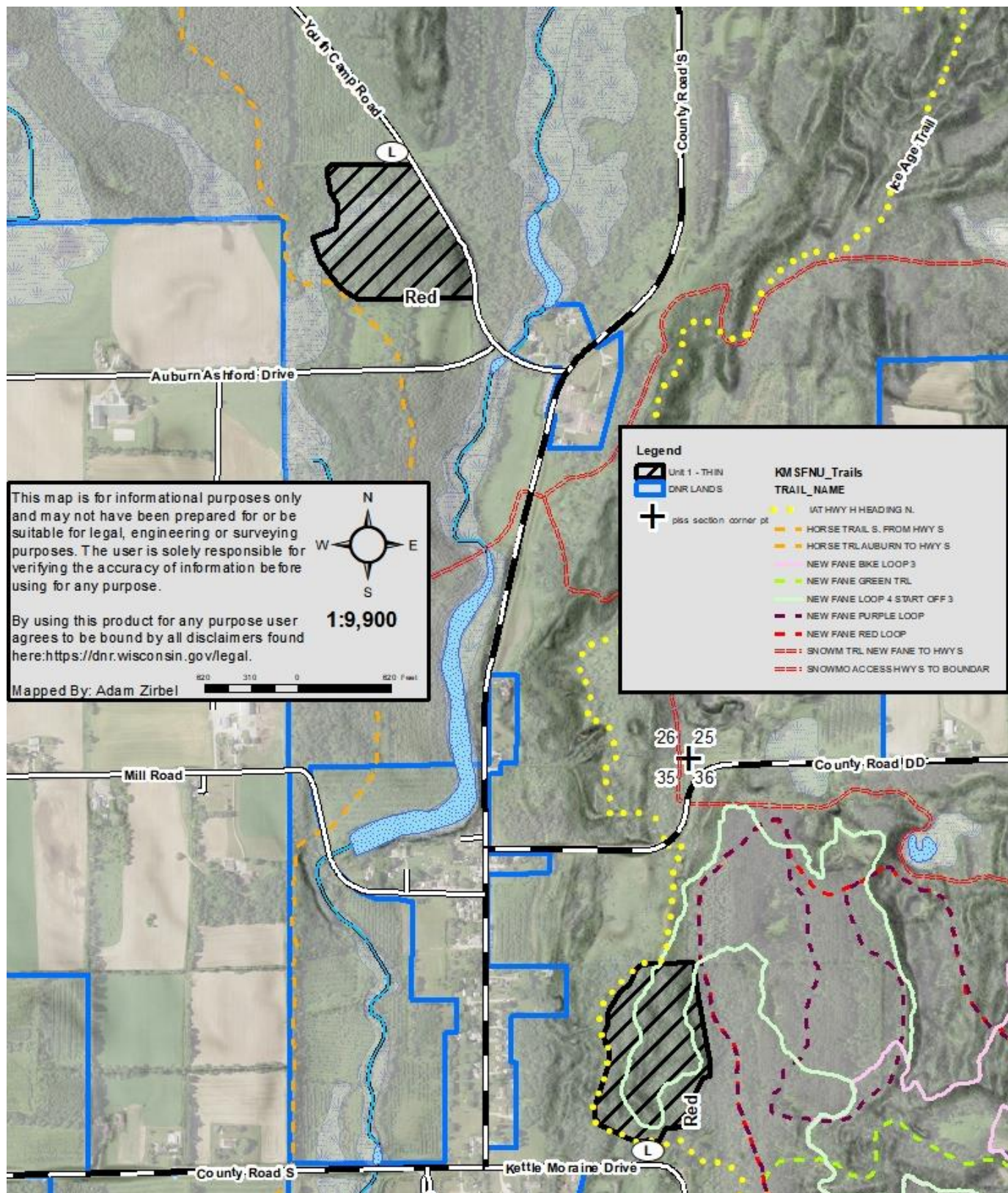

Operational Considerations:

- 1) Harvesting operations allowed on dry or frozen ground conditions between **August 21 and March 1**.
- 2) No harvesting during gun deer opening weekend and a period starting Thanksgiving through the close of the 9-day traditional gun deer season.
- 3) In the hardwood thinning areas cut all and only trees marked with orange paint.
- 4) The ice age trail and mountain bike trails can only be crossed at pre-determined locations.
- 5) Any debris entering any of the trail areas within 15 feet of trail surfaces shall be removed immediately.
- 6) Slash shall be lopped and/or scattered evenly across sale area and lie within three (3) feet of the ground.
- 7) The logging contractor will provide warning signage where any of the trails enter the timber sale area.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].
