SPECIFIC CUTTING REQUIREMENTS:

- An on-site meeting is required prior to any harvesting to discuss operational concerns.
- Trees marked with an orange slash are designated for harvest.
- Ironwood have been marked with orange slashes, but do not account for the offered timber volume or value of the sale. The removal of ironwood is not required, however the contactor may remove and utilize it if desired.
- Harvesting operations may occur during the following timeframes: November 1st through March 31st.
- Dry or frozen grounds are required to limit disturbance and rutting.
- Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD) Treatment. This sale requires the Purchaser to complete HRD preventive treatment 4/1-11/30. Treatment must be performed by a Certified Pesticide Applicator. Treatment involves treating all fresh-cut stumps of conifers of merchantable size by applying either CELLU-TREAT (disodium octaborate tetrahydrate) or Rotstop C (Phlebiopsis gigantea). Treatment shall be made as soon as possible and no later than one day after harvest. A dye product shall be added to liquid solutions for inspection purposes. The cost of this

application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales.

- Utilize saw logs to 10” and pulp to a 4” top.
- All slash shall be lopped and/or scattered to lie within four feet of the ground; slash must also be removed from all public access trails, field, parking lot and roads. Slash shall be removed from these areas so that it does not lie on OR protrude into the trail zone. Slash that may fall in these areas must be removed immediately. This is to be done concurrent with the cutting operation.
- Any standing dead snags are to be left if they do not pose a hazard to logging contractors.
- Residual tress shall not be excessively damaged. Residual damage will not be tolerated and excessive damage to residual trees will be subject to penalty.
- Haul roads, skid trails, and landings must be approved by local DNR Forester and must conform to DNR Best Management Practices.
- Primary sale access will be off HWY 167 (Holy Hill Road).
- Walking trails must be avoided by heavy equipment and may only be used to cross over when necessary. Trails can only be used for skidding if approved by DNR staff.
- Trails will be temporarily closed or re-routed by DNR staff.
- Contractor must utilize signage designating timber harvesting areas near trails.
- Contractor must utilize signage on the roads near landings and access points in both directions along HWY 167 warning motorists of logging trucks entering roadway.

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

- Mill scale, weight or measured, shall be used for all forest products. The ticket system will be utilized for all wood hauled. If wood is being hauled to a purchaser that cannot or will not return a scale slip to this Forest, then the wood must be scaled by the Forest representative before being hauled. Deferred payment for stumpage is allowed on this sale unless successful bidder is on the advance pay list.
- Contract length will allow for 3 full years to cut and may not be sub-contracted or assigned.
- A copy of state contract available upon request; contract may contain additional provisions.
- Logging roads, skid trails and landings must be approved, graded smooth, and seeded at completion and will be restricted to the harvest area whenever possible.
- The Purchaser agrees to take all steps and precautions to avoid and minimize soil disturbances, such as soil compaction and rutting. If soil disturbances occur, the Purchaser agrees to work cooperatively to mitigate and repair any and all instances of soil disturbance. Rutting must not be more than 6 inches deep.
- Upon arrival on site, logging equipment shall be clean of soil or debris from other sites to minimize the chance for introduction of exotic plants.
- The volume offered for sale is estimated but not guaranteed. If there is less timber than estimated, there is no obligation of the DNR to make up the “shortage”.

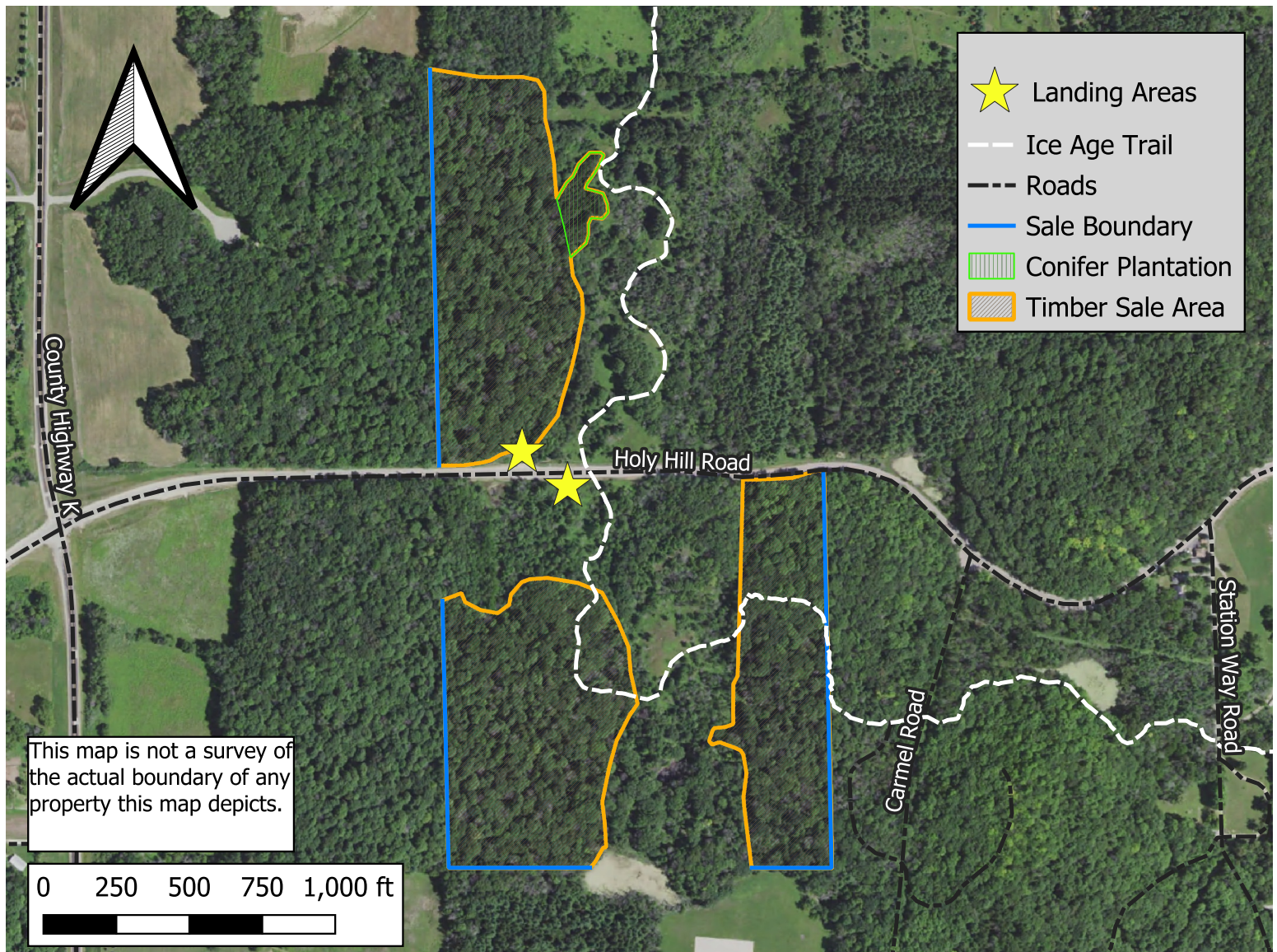

- Ironwood have been marked with orange slashes, but do not account for the timber volume or value of the sale. Removal of ironwood is not required, however the contractor may remove and utilize it if desired.
- Timber sale boundaries are marked with blue chevrons.
- HRD treatments required in conifer plantation if harvesting from April 1st to November 30th.
- Dry or frozen grounds are required to limit disturbance and rutting.
- Powerlines run along the north side of Holy Hill Road.
