### **BIDDING REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales
  - a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
  - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
  - c. The <u>high bidder</u> will be determined by the <u>greatest total bid</u> for each tract.
  - d. Bids will be opened in random order.
  - e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.
- 2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
- 3. Submit each bid in an **individual sealed envelope** marked "Bid for Timber Stumpage" with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus
- 4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No "zero" bids for any species or products will be accepted.
- 5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
- 6. A <u>Performance Bond or Letter of Credit</u> is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Performance bonds in a form of other than cash for these sales must expire no earlier than **1-year past contract expiration date.**
- 7. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

# SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A <u>Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate</u> must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. # SCALING AND PAYMENT

- 1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
- 2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
- 3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
- 4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
- 5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square with at least 10 cords per pile or 5 MBF. At least 20 cords or 10 MBF will be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.
- 6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
- 7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
- 8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species prorates/conversions.

# **CONTRACT PERIOD**

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening will expire on June 30, 2027.

### **CONTRACT EXTENSIONS**

### **Cutting Specifications**

- Unit 1 Pine thinning area 32 acres: Cut all orange-marked trees. Only shortwood skidding allowed in sale.
   Red & Blue paint represent the end of some of the harvest unit. Along Silver Fox Road the harvest area ends with the orange marked trees.
- All harvested pieces with at least a 4-inch diameter on the small end must be utilized.
- Whole tree harvesting is permitted on this sale only with short wood skidding. 1 in 10 tops must remain on site if whole tree is utilized.

### **Operational Considerations-**

- Verbal permission given from adjacent landowner to harvest area (see map & Landowner has access to Hwy. 64 directly as well). Agreement to use access is between the Contractor and the Landowner (Brandon Zinkowich 920-851-7360) or through DNR land, however this would require a stream crossing permit. Prior notification to DNR is needed for the stream crossing.

  - 1. The contractor shall purchase and apply an approved fungicide to all cut Pine and Spruce stumps and horizontal wound surfaces.
  - 2. Pesticide applicators must be certified/licensed by DATCP for this treatment.
  - 3. All stumps shall be treated by the end of each day.
  - 4. All stumps shall be left clear of logging slash to allow for the application and inspection of the approved fungicide.
  - 5. A marker dye shall be added to the solution to monitor application coverage.

#### Modifications to HRD treatment:

- 1. Prolonged, unusually warm weather during the winter period (December 1 March 31), treatment may be recommended.
- 2. Prolonged, unusually cold weather outside the winter period (outside of December 1 March 31), treatment may not be necessary.
- 3. Deep snow cover (at least 12 inches) outside of the winter period (outside of December 1 March 31), treatment may not be necessary



- Unit 1 Salvage 4 acres: Harvest all trees at 45-degree angle or 50% of the crown removed (discuss at presale), ash and ironwood. All red oak shall not be cut. Exterior of the harvest area marked with trees with a red band. A red dot faces into the salvage area. Red marked trees shall not be cut. Tip up mounds from root balls shall be retained at 2-6 per acre. Hemlock in this area will be left "as is" unless an issue to the Contractor to aid in tip up mound retention. Some blown over trees may require Contractor to position stump & root ball to achieve density of 2-6 per acre.

Various woods roads gives access to the cutting areas. To access the areas south of the Little Eau Pleine River, use the DNR parking lot off Frey Ave. From there, follow the snowmobile trail 1.4 miles east to the cutting area.

### **Cutting Specifications:**

- **Area 1 (39 Acres)**: Cut all trees marked in orange paint. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches in diameter within purple paint boundaries including purple marked trees. Leave all conifer species.
- **Area 2 (20 Acres):** Cut all trees greater than 2" in diameter within the stand boundaries except for oak species.
- **Area 3 (7 Acres):** Cut all trees greater than 2" in diameter within the stand boundaries except for trees marked in green bands. Leave all conifer species.
- Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Non-merchantable trees must be cut concurrent with merchantable trees. Whole tree harvesting will not be permitted in this sale.


