Harvesting during snowmobile season will require that roads be kept free of logging debris daily.

Upon sale completion, all roads shall be leveled and returned to as good or better condition.

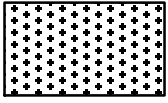

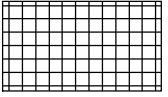
