Mixed pulp<sup>1</sup> includes approx. 72% of sugar maple, 27% of red maple, 1% white birch, elm, ironwood, and oak. Tamarack<sup>2</sup> includes 50% tamarack and 50% spruce. The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately three years.

## SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions. Sale will most likely need frozen ground conditions due to low, wet access into sale areas.

No harvesting during the months of April, May, or June in selection areas due to bark being easily damaged at these times.

A culvert will be needed on main haul road. The contractor is responsible for purchasing and placing the culvert. The culvert will remain in place after the sale is completed.

If decking on hunter/walker trail or main haul road, all slash and ends will be removed from the road and ditches concurrently with each truckload. The hunter/walker trail and main haul road will be kept free of debris.

Access to western stands will require road building and/or timber mats. Access from adjoining Sawyer County Forest Land (if desired) is the responsibility of the contractor. Any access used through Sawyer County Forest Land needs to be bermed at the state forest boundary.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut areas due to density and distribution of regeneration.

The roads and trails may be used for multiple sales, it is the responsibility of the contractors of sales to determine the logistics for hauling and/or repairs.

Road work within the Old Growth Study Area shall be kept to a minimum.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
