The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract end date is June 30, 2024

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will be restricted to frozen ground conditions only due to wet soil conditions and accessibility.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the selection area due to density and distribution of regeneration.

Access can either be from the north woods trail or from Myers Farm Road. If accessing from Myers Farm Rd, a temporary in-stream crossing using timber mats will be required. All conditions of the temporary in-stream crossing, which will be obtained by the Flambeau River State Forest, will be followed by the contractor. The mats must be placed during frozen conditions and removed prior to spring thaw.

No wheeled or tracked harvesting equipment will be operated within 15 feet of the ordinary high-water mark of the unnamed stream except on roads or at stream crossing.

Erosion control materials will need to be placed by contractor at locations indicated on map.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
