Mixed Pulp also includes 6 MBF red maple, 3 MBF ash, 2 MBF white birch, 2 MBF hard maple, and 1 MBF basswood.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the Mixed Pulp price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ending date will be June 30, 2024.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

No logging April 1st – June 30th in the single tree selection and group selection areas of the sale due to bark being easily damaged on residual trees during this timeframe.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed within the single tree and group selection areas due to density and distribution of regeneration.

Sale boundary trees (painted red, yellow, purple or blue) shall not be cut.

Best access to sale area is through private land using multiple access roads off of Up River Road. It is the responsibility of the contractor to secure access with private parties. It is possible that the access road may be in use for multiple sales at one time; it is the responsibility of the contractors of these sales to determine the logistics for hauling and road maintenance and/or repairs.

Upon sale completion, all woods roads and access points shall be leveled, re-ditched if necessary, and returned to the condition prior to the sale.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
