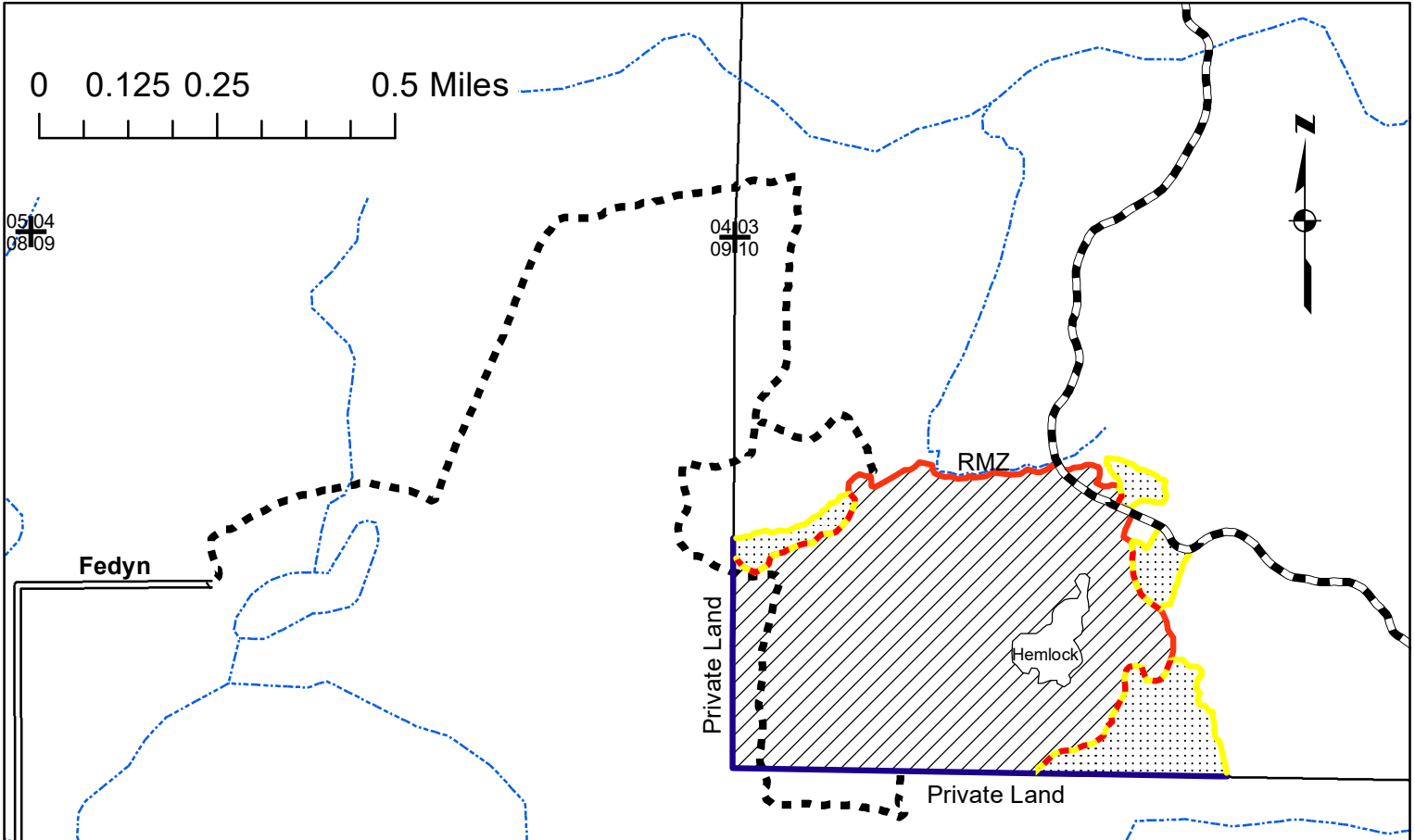

## Timber Sale Area - 157 Acres

- Single Tree Selection - 132 Acres - Cut all trees marked in ORANGE paint. Cut all Aspen, Ironwood, White Birch and Black Ash 5" DBH and greater. DO NOT cut conifer.
- Coppice - 25 Acres - Cut all stems 2" DBH and larger. DO NOT cut conifer and oak.

## Forester Notes

- \*The use of a continuously rotating saw head (ie. Hot Saw) is prohibited in the single tree selection area.
- \*Frozen ground harvesting.
- \*No felling of trees across Blue Paint Line.
- \*Snowmobile trail shall be kept open, snow-covered, and free of debris.
- \*Access through private land must be secured by contractor.
- \*3 Miles North from sale area to Thornapple Grade on snowmobile trail.
