Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed hardwood/saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. The contract end date is **June 30, 2025**

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will only be allowed during frozen ground conditions due to wet access into timber sale area.

Upland fill shall not be placed on access points that cross wetlands. If necessary, organic material such as corduroy or slash can be used. As much of this material as feasible, given site and material conditions, should be removed promptly when the work is complete.

Woods trails will remain open and free of debris.

Debris berm is required at present berm location at the completion of the sale.

Permission by Forester to deck on Price Creek Road is required. If decking is allowed, all slash and ends will be removed from the road and ditches concurrently with each truck load.
