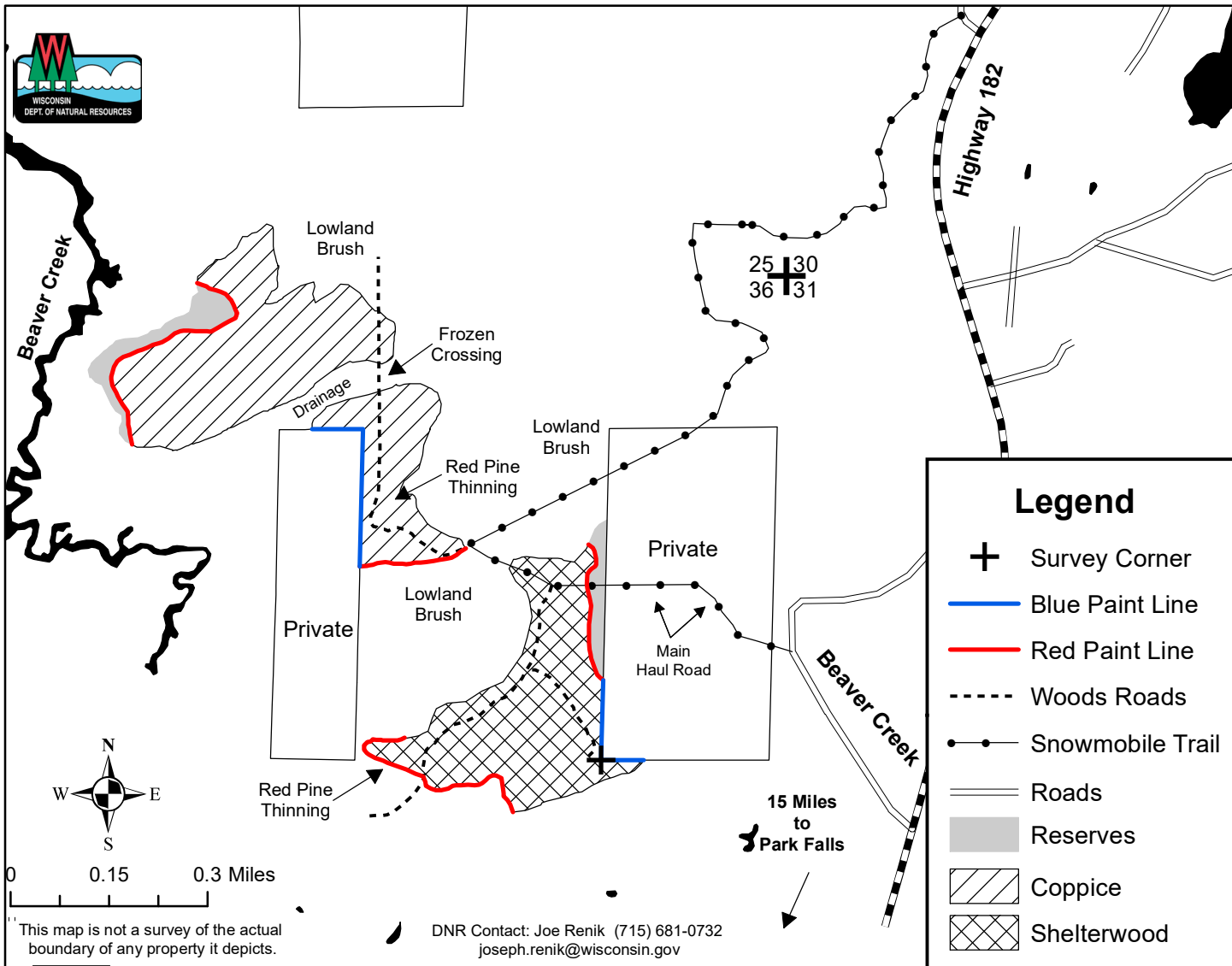

- **Coppice Area (64 acres)**, harvest all trees greater than 4" and all orange marked trees except for green marked trees, cedar, hemlock, tamarack, unmarked pine and spruce less than 10" and greater than 18".

- **Shelterwood Area (43 acres)**, harvest all trees greater than 4" and all orange marked trees except for green marked trees, cedar, hemlock, spruce, tamarack and unmarked pine.

- All trees felled across blue paint boundaries must be pulled back into the cutting area before limbing and bucking.

-Snowmobile trail must remain snow covered and in a safe, usable condition and free of equipment and logging debris at all times. Decking along snowmobile trail is allowed as long as wood is decked far enough away so that it does not create a hazard for snowmobilers.

-All pine harvested between May 1st and September 15th must be hauled within 14 days.

-Dry or frozen ground operations only. Access to the northern portion of the sale must occur during frozen conditions.

-The State has secured access to the timber sale, however, it is the contractor's responsibility to gain access across private property.

¹Mixed Hardwood consists of 59% red maple, 30% hard maple, 5% white birch, 4% cherry, 1% yellow birch and 1% basswood.

³Sawtimber includes 66% red maple, 33% hard maple and 1% white birch.

²Red Pine includes 14 tons of white pine. Average DBH of red pine is 15".

Utilization on all species is 100" to a 4" top.
