Harvesting Prescription

Selection Harvest Area 56 Acres - Cut all orange marked trees, no slash allowed within the dry wash areas or over blue paint lines. Orange marked trees within the dry wash areas may be harvested.

Coppice Area 30 Acres – Cut all stems 2” DBH and greater except conifer and green marked trees, orange marked trees within the dry wash may also be harvested. This area will be harvested during frozen ground conditions. DNR will mechanically shear this area prior to harvest to remove woody competition.

Note: The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length will be three years,

Expires June 30th, 2027.

General Sale Conditions

- Utilization standards, 4” top.
- Slash lopped or scattered to lie within 2 feet of the ground, no slash across blue lines.
- No equipment allowed within 15 feet of dry wash areas, fine slash can remain in the dry wash areas as long as water flow in not stopped.
- Slash from upland harvesting may not be left in wetland areas, slash generated from harvesting within the wetland edge may be left.
- Access to sale is through state land off the end of Kent Rd and Bednarek Rd, there is a gate at the end of Kent Rd.
- Rutting policy will be enforced per contract.
- The use of a continuously rotating saw head is prohibited in the single tree selection area.
- Pole Skidding is not allowed within the selection harvest area.
- Contractor will need to work with township if wood needs to be decked on town road.
- New road and landing sites require prior approval from the forester.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
