Utilization specifications for cordwood will be 1 stick (100 inches) to a 6-inch top diameter.

¹Mixed hardwood includes 56% hard maple, 29% red maple, 6% yellow birch, 4% ash, 2% white birch, and 3% cherry, basswood, elm, and ironwood combined.

²Mixed softwood includes 62% spruce and 38% balsam.

³Mixed saw includes 13 MBF red maple, 5 MBF ash, 2 MBF yellow birch, and a small amount of white birch.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. The contract end date is **June 30, 2027**

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.

Portions of this sale are within the Flambeau River Scenic Management Area. Operations within this area are limited to leaf off conditions (approximately October 15th through March 31st). **Additionally**, operations will need to be completed before February 15th in the area indicated on the map.

No cutting during the months of April, May, or June in selection areas due to bark being easily damaged at these times.

If decking on Nedli Rd or the open road leading to private property, all slash and ends will be removed from the roads and ditches concurrently with each truckload. Public passage will be allowed during sale operations.

Nedli Rd is a snowmobile/ATV trail. Three inches of snow will be maintained on the trail, weather permitting.

To make areas of sale operable during dry conditions, existing trails will most likely need pit run material. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling any pit run needed for decking on these existing trails.

There are maintained wildlife openings bordering the timber sale area. These areas shall not be used for landings or decking. these areas should also not be heavily used by equipment such as for turn arounds or skid trails.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
