Utilization specifications for cordwood will be 1 stick (100 inches) to a 6-inch top diameter.

¹Mixed pulp includes 61% hard maple, 36% red maple, 3% basswood.

²Mixed saw is primarily basswood.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp/saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ending date will be **June 30, 2027**.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will only be allowed during frozen ground conditions due to wet access conditions.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the selection areas due to density and distribution of regeneration.

Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction will be limited to the proposed road location layout on prospectus map. Modifications may be made with approval of forester.

A temporary stream crossing is required to cross the stream located on the map. The permit for the crossing has been obtained by the Flambeau River State Forest. The design will require timber mats. All conditions of the temporary in-stream crossing permit will be followed by the contractor.

Wet crossings indicated on map will require poles, frozen ground conditions, and/or timber mats.

There is an alternative access through Aurora Sustainable Lands. Contractor is responsible for obtaining access with land manager of Aurora Sustainable Lands. Contact and access information can be obtained by calling forester listed below.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
