Equipment use will only be allowed during <u>very</u> dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions in black ash/red maple coppice area.

Proposed back-in and existing woods trails are indicated on map and may be used to access the harvest areas. Modifications may be made with approval of forester. Other new construction must be approved by forester.

There is a proposed back-in location indicated on the map. If the back-in is used, it will need pit run material to make the area operable during non-frozen conditions. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling. The driveway permit for the back-in has not been established at this time. To meet permit specifications, the state will provide the culvert, but the placement of the culvert is the responsibility of the contractor.

If the proposed back-in is used, a debris berm will need to be placed at this location.

The woods trail north of sale will need frozen conditions to access sale.

If harvesting during very dry conditions, timber mats or tops will be needed at wet crossing indicated on map.

All slash within 100' of County Road W will be lopped and scattered to within 2' of the ground.
