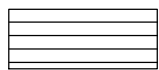


Tract 3-24 (Oscar's Can) – Flambeau River State Forest

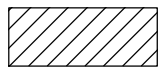
Parts of: SE ¼ Sec 11, N ½ Sec 14 T39N R3W Town of Draper, Sawyer County



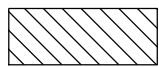

Overstory Removal Area (133 acres) – Bounded by green paint, blue paint, young aspen, and red pine plantation. Harvest all trees greater than 2 inches except: 1) hemlock, 2) pine, 3) cedar, 4) oak, 5) green marked trees, and 6) balsam fir 2 sticks or less. Cut all red pine marked with orange. Leave all snags. *Preserve as much existing regeneration as possible.*



Red Pine Plantation (5 acres) – No boundary paint. Harvest all orange marked trees.



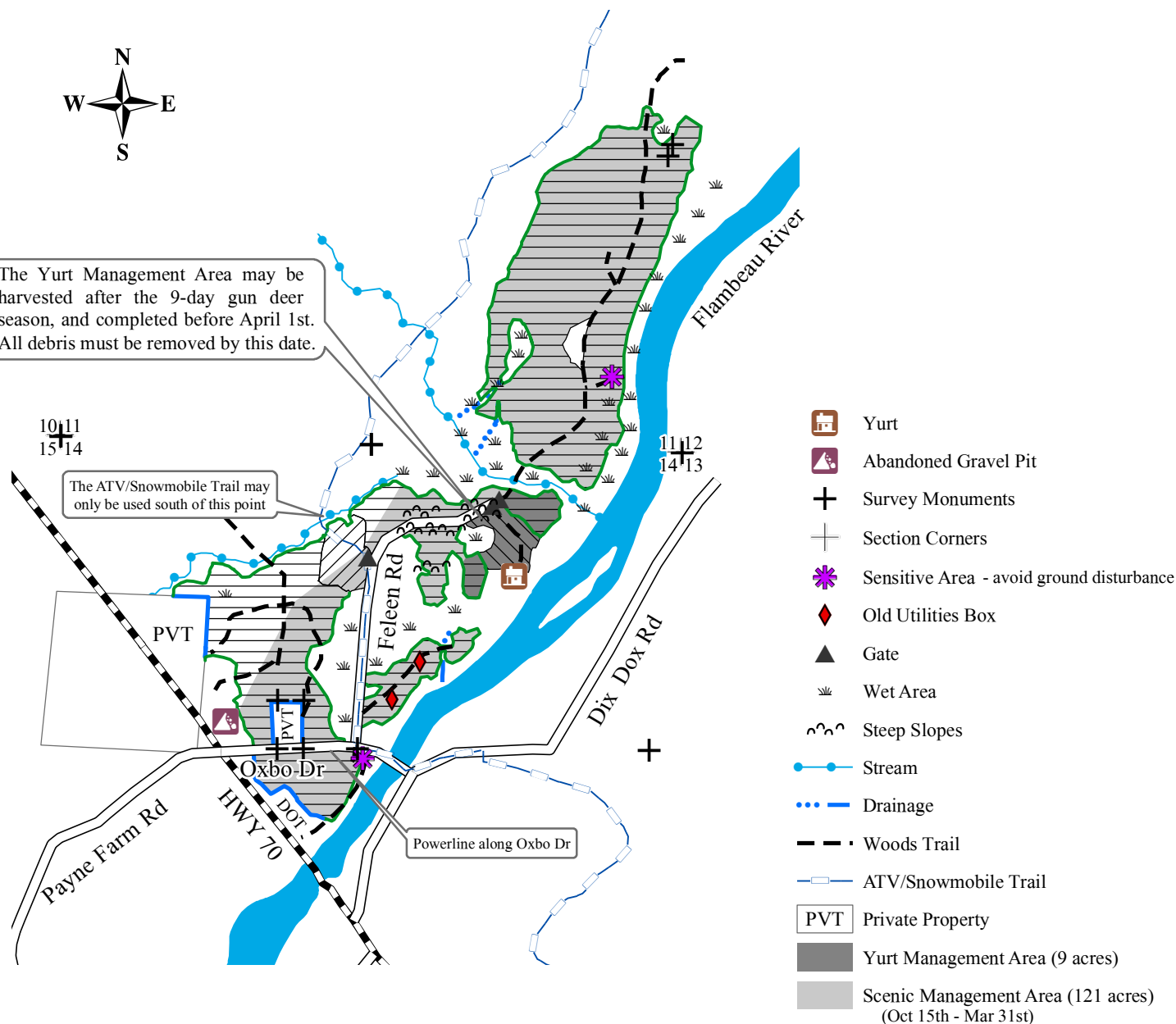
Selection Area (5 acres) – No boundary paint. Harvest all orange marked trees and all aspen.

Total acres: 143

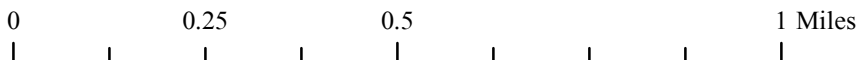


The Yurt Management Area may be harvested after the 9-day gun deer season, and completed before April 1st. All debris must be removed by this date.

The ATV/Snowmobile Trail may only be used south of this point
