











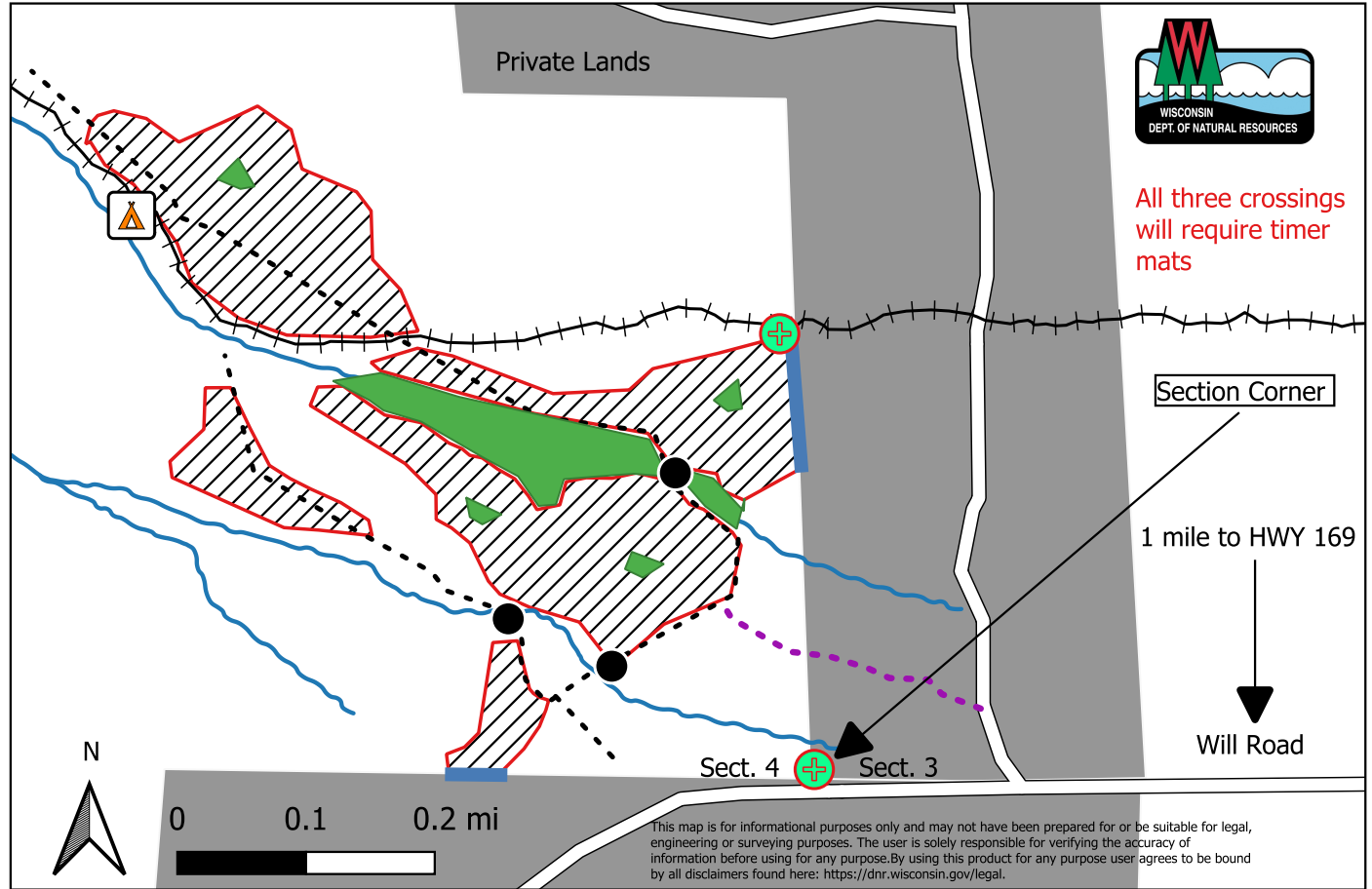

Aspen Coppice (76 acres):
 Cut all stems 2" and larger except: Oak, Hemlock, Cedar, red pine, and white pine. Also reserve all yellow birch over 14" DBH.
 Sale area bound by red and blue paint lines.
 Do not cut areas with green paint. (Green Leave tree areas may not be mapped exactly)

Special Considerations:

- Contract end date of June 30, 2028
- Frozen road and stream crossing required to reach aspen units (crossing must be permitted, DNR will supply permit)
- Minimum utilization on all species is 100" to 4" top for pulp and 10" top for logs
- No new roads or landings without permission from DNR
- Mill Scale Sale
- Best access maybe through private lands. Permissions to cross private lands will be up to contractor to secure.
