<sup>1</sup>Mixed pulp includes 9% hard maple, 50% red maple, 25% ash, 7% white birch, and 9% yellow birch, basswood, elm, ironwood, and cherry combined.

Mixed pulp also includes 10 MBF hard maple, 38 MBF red maple, 17 MBF ash, 6 MBF basswood, and small amounts of elm, white birch and yellow birch combined.

<sup>2</sup>Mixed conifer includes 55% balsam fir and 45% tamarack.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp/mixed conifer price.

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The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. **The contract end date is June 30, 2029.**

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

Operations are permitted during frozen ground conditions only.

Access to the sale requires two stream crossings. The permits have been obtained by the Flambeau River State Forest. All components of the stream crossings will occur during frozen ground conditions only. All parts of the stream crossing permits, including use of timber mats, will be followed by the contractor.

Proposed roads are indicated on map. Modifications may be made with approval of forester. Other new construction must be approved by forester.

Contractor is required to close road at designated map location by placing a debris berm.
