<sup>2</sup>Red Pine includes 5 MBF sawtimber (average cut d.b.h. = 11")

<sup>3</sup>Mixed Conifer consists of 60% white pine, 35% balsam fir, and 5% white spruce.

<sup>4</sup>Mixed Hardwood Saw includes 20 MBF red oak, 15 MBF basswood, 15 MBF red maple, 5 MBF white birch, and 5 MBF yellow birch.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the Mixed Hardwood or Mixed Conifer price accordingly.

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The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ending date will be **June 30, 2029**.

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

Harvesting will be allowed between July 16 and March 31 in most sale areas. In gray areas, harvesting is limited to between September 19 and March 31. Access during the July 16 through September 18 timeframe will only be allowed from the north. (See timber sale map for clarification).

Wood removed from the Hardwood Shelterwood Area and Pine Thinning Area can only be skidded/forwarded along existing woods road trails (no semi truck traffic or significant road improvements in these areas).

Logging debris berm will need to be placed at the Proposed Berm location designated on map following timber harvest.

Any changes to road layout shall only be made with DNR sale administrator approval.

If wood is decked along Rock Creek Road/Open Forest Road, it can only be hauled from September 19 through March 31. All slash and ends shall be removed from roads and ditches concurrently with each truckload to minimize logging debris concerns.
