


Department of Natural Resources Notice of Sealed Bids



Sealed bids will be received by the Department of Natural Resources for timber stumpage on the Straight Lake State Park, Straight Lake Wildlife Area, Rice Beds Creek Wildlife Area, Loon Lake Wildlife Area, Governor Knowles State Forest, Namekagon Barrens, Totogatic Wildlife Area, Amsterdam Sloughs Wildlife Area, Sand Creek Fishery Area, Fish Lake Wildlife Area and Crex Meadows. These timber sales are third party certified. Bids may be hand delivered or mailed to the following: No emailed bids

Bids will be opened on **Tuesday, May 14th, 2019 at 1:00 pm** at the DNR Forestry office in the County Admin Building in Balsam Lake. No bid will be accepted after the date and time of the bid opening. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids.

Bids should be made with an as-is understanding:

- The Department does not guarantee access to sales across any non-state-owned lands.
- DNR Foresters will assist in obtaining any necessary permits. The contractor will be responsible for any permit fees and any installation, removal and restoration costs.
- The State does not guarantee volumes. Bidders are strongly encouraged to inspect sales to make their own volume and quality determinations.

Bidding procedure is as follows:

1. Bid bond not required.
2. Each timber sale map contains one sale and is for informational purposes. To bid for a particular sale, the contractor must submit their bids on DNR Form 2400-49, TIMBER SALE BID. Bid sheets are included for each sale. Bids for each tract must be submitted in a separate sealed envelope.
3. Each bid submitted must include contractor's bid per rough cord, ton, or thousand board feet for each species as listed, and the bidder's signature.
4. Acceptable bids must meet or exceed the total advertised sale value. Bids below total advertised sale value or that are incomplete will be rejected. A bid of zero for a particular species or product will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted.
5. Some tracts may have optional species or areas where bidders may elect to bid on only those species not marked as optional. Bids will be awarded on highest total sale value. This applies to only those tracts with optional species listed on the timber sale map (prospectus).
6. Bids for variable top diameter utilization will be accepted only on those sales that list whole tree volumes or otherwise indicate it is allowed. Contractors submitting a bid for variable top diameter utilization, including whole tree harvesting, must clearly indicate on the Timber Sale Bid (Form 2400-49) the species, utilization specifications, estimated volume, and price per unit they will be using. The appropriate volume is listed on the Timber Sale Map by top diameter and whole tree. Bidding will be on an MBF, cordwood equivalent basis, or ton as indicated on the prospectus. The Department of Natural Resources weight conversion rates will be used.
The timber sale contract (Form 2400-5) will indicate the utilization specification and bid value you are bidding at. You will be required to harvest and utilize the wood at the utilization specification that you bid.
7. Bidders in attendance can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Tracts are opened in random order.

All Sales

1. Contracts are to be signed within six weeks of receiving the contract and are considered binding for that period. Sample contracts are available upon request. Contracts may not be sub-contracted or assigned.
2. A performance bond of a minimum of \$1000.00 or 15% of the total sale, whichever is greater is required on each sale. Performance bonds are due 6 weeks after the bid opening. If the winning bidder fails to sign the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year period.
3. Successful purchasers of DNR stumpage will need to ensure that the actual logging contractor engaged in performance of this contract complies with the Wisconsin SFI Training Standard. Criteria for the standard can be found at the website www.fistausa.org or by contacting FISTA. Documentation confirming completion of the training standard will be required prior to starting sale.
4. The successful bidder must comply with Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act, Chapter 102 of Wisconsin Statutes. The successful bidder **MUST HAVE WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE**, and must provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance indicating the Department of Natural Resources as a "certificate holder".
5. The contractor must contact the appropriate Department of Natural Resources office a minimum of two working days prior to starting a sale contract and attend a pre-sale meeting. Failure to do so will be considered a contract violation and a portion of the performance bond can be retained.
6. If mixed loads of different valued species are hauled, the stumpage charges will be calculated based on the proportion of the different species as determined by the mill. If the mill fails to assign a percentage to the different valued species the entire load will be charged to the species with the higher stumpage rate. All mixed loads hauled under the Haul Permit system **MUST** have indicated on the ticket the different valued species and estimated volumes of each.
7. Scaling arrangements on all sales will be made at the time of contract signing and Department conversion rates for weight, peeled, or processed fuelwood will be utilized. The Department will convert any mill weight scales to cordwood or ton volume using the Department conversion rates.

Payment Options

Scaled Sales

DEFERRED STUMPAGE PAYMENT OPTION

The successful bidder may choose the Deferred Payment option if eligible. In this case, stumpage payments must be received by the State within 30 days of being billed by the forester. Advance stumpage payment is not required. This option does not apply to lump sum sales

ADVANCED STUMPAGE PAYMENT OPTION

An advance stumpage will be required before any cutting begins, and as needed throughout the sale period. No wood will be removed from the sale area at any time until it has been paid for.

Lump Sum Sales

All lump sum timber sales require a 100% stumpage payment prior to cutting. No haul tickets will be used. Failure to fully complete performance will result in forfeiture of the total performance bond. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller. Payment may be split into payment blocks at the discretion of the sale administrator (forester).

Contract Extensions

Contract lengths are given on the prospectus or the timber sale map. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions will be for 1 year. They will be considered with the following conditions:

Two year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate
- Additional extensions - if permitted an additional 15% increase in stumpage rate.

Three year Contracts

- 1st extension – 20% increase in stumpage rate
- Additional extensions - if permitted an additional 15% increase in stumpage rate.



Cutting Requirements / Information

- Area #1 – Harvest all trees marked with orange paint.
- Area #2 – Harvest all trees over 2 inches in diameter except leave all den trees, snags that are not a hazard.
- Cutting, skidding, or hauling allowed only when access road is frozen.** (typically late November to spring breakup)
No cutting, skidding or hauling during any wet periods or when rutting may occur. Operations must cease if rutting occurs.
No operations during regular gun deer season. Leave all den trees, marked or not.
- Wisconsin BMP's for water quality must be followed around numerous small wetlands.
- Care must be taken to avoid damage to residual trees. No tops or trees are to be left hanging in standing trees and slash must be lopped to below 3 feet and kept within sale area. If excessive damage occurs to residual trees, fines will be imposed, and equipment and/or operators will be restricted.
- Utilization: 4" top.
- Access is off of County Highway G, 2 miles east of CTY E. Landings will be in existing landings and/or along access road.
No new roads will be built.
- All roads used will be cleared and smoothed to allow seeding by DNR after sale completion.
- This is a scaled sale for sawlogs and mill scale sale for the pulpwood. A sawlog (other than aspen) is defined as a merchantable log 8'6" long 10" dib small end. Two year contract.

Description of Stumpage: This is a 75 acre timber sale of Oak, Northern Hardwoods, and Aspen sawlogs and pulpwood. Ground is high and dry with numerous small wetlands. Quality of the oak is good to excellent. Size is pole timber to small sawlog with some large trees. The stand has been managed in the past. Volume estimation is based on 100% tally. Topwood was estimated.



1. Area #1 – Harvest all trees over 2 inches in diameter except leave any trees marked with green paint, den trees or snags that are not a hazard. This is an aspen regeneration area.
2. Area #2 – Harvest all aspen and all trees marked with orange paint.
3. No cutting, skidding, or hauling from spring breakup(mid march) to August 10th. No cutting, skidding or hauling during any wet periods or when rutting may occur. Operations must cease if rutting occurs. No operations during regular gun deer season. Leave all den trees, marked or not.
4. Wisconsin BMP's for water quality must be followed around wetlands and vernal pools.
5. Care must be taken to avoid damage to residual trees. No tops or trees are to be left hanging in standing trees and slash must be lopped to below 3 feet and kept within sale area. If excessive damage occurs to residual trees, fines will be imposed, and equipment and/or operators will be restricted.
6. Utilization: 4" top.



1. Sale Area – Harvest all aspen and all trees marked with orange paint. Leave all den trees or snags that are not a hazard, marked or not.
2. Cutting, skidding, or hauling allowed from August 10th to spring breakup (usually mid march) when dry or frozen and rutting will not occur. Operations must cease if rutting occurs. No operations during regular gun deer season.
3. Wisconsin BMP's for water quality must be followed around any wetlands and/or vernal pools.
4. Care must be taken to avoid damage to residual trees. No tops or trees are to be left hanging in standing trees and slash must be lopped to below 3 feet and kept within sale area. If excessive damage occurs to residual trees, fines will be imposed, and equipment and/or operators will be restricted.
5. Utilization: 4" top.



1. First thinning pine plantation. Harvest every other row from within the harvest area.
2. No cutting, skidding, or hauling from spring breakup(mid march) to June 1st. No cutting, skidding or hauling during any wet periods or when rutting may occur. Operations must cease if rutting occurs at any time.
3. Wood must be hauled within 3 weeks of cutting when beetles are active.
4. Care must be taken to avoid damage to residual trees. No tops or trees are to be left hanging in standing trees and slash must be lopped to below 3 feet and kept within sale area. If excessive damage occurs to residual trees, fines will be imposed, and equipment and/or operators will be restricted.
5. No slash within 10 feet of the ice age trail. Trail will not be used for forwarding and minimally crossed.
6. Utilization: 4" top.
7. Landings will be in field to the west of the plantation or along 140th street if town allows it. Parking area on southeast corner will not be used.
