 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.



- 9. Landings shall be located where indicated on the prospectus map unless prior approval is obtained from the administering forester or the property manager. Decking of wood along the recreation trail is allowed as long as the decked wood does not extend out onto the road surface.
- 10. Recreation trail surface will have to be restored to at least existing condition and any damaged signs/posts will have to be replaced by the contractor. Recreation trail shall be maintained snow covered during winter months and free of debris at all times.
