

## NH-ALSF TRACT NO. 24-18 BJ Airport Pine

#### Vilas County

Township 42 North, Range 7 East

Section 5 – NESW, SESW, NWSE, SWSE, SESE

Section 8 – NENE, NWNE, SWNE, SENW, NESW, NWSE

The cutting area is approximately 77 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole tree harvest is not allowed.

#### **Special Conditions**

- 1. Slash adjacent to Airport Road, Dairymens Road, and the airport runways must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. Pull back at least ten feet behind tree line.
- 2. Biomass harvesting is not allowed.
- 3. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.
- 4. All vehicles and equipment are prohibited from the airport runways.

¹ Contains approximately 88% red pine, 2% white pine, 9% jack pine, and ~1% northern pin oak. Included in this volume is approximately 145 MBF red pine and 4 MBF white pine. Weight conversion: 2.241 tons/cord.

Total sale volume equates to 27.3 tons/acre or 12.2 cords/acre.
