**Invitation for Bids on the
NORTHERN HIGHLAND-AMERICAN LEGION STATE FOREST
Winter 2019**

Sealed bids will be received by the Forest Superintendent, Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest, at the **Trout Lake Forestry Headquarters**, Boulder Junction, Wisconsin up until Noon Wednesday, January 9th, 2019 for the four (4) Tracts on the Northern Highland American Legion. After that time, you should hand deliver to the Woodruff DNR Service Center up until 1:30 PM. These tracts comprise a total of 371 acres and contain estimated volumes of 15,555 tons of pulpwood and 121 MBF of sawlogs.

A timber sale prospectus and detailed information including maps of each tract, as well as required bid forms and copies of sample contract forms, can be obtained by contacting the Trout Lake Forestry Headquarters, by calling (715) 904-1169 or viewing our website at <http://dnr.wi.gov/topic/TimberSales/salesNHAL.html>

Bids must be submitted on Department "Timber Sale Bid" Forms.
Contractors desiring to bid on more than one tract must submit separate bids and separate envelopes for each tract. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any or all bids. Bids will be opened publicly at the Woodruff DNR Service Center located at 8770 County HWY J, Woodruff, WI at 1:30 PM on the date specified at the beginning of this notice.

These lands are Third Party Certified.

BID BOND POLICY

There is no bid bond required. However, winning bidders will have up to 6 weeks from the date of the bid opening to submit an acceptable performance bond to the department. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year period
