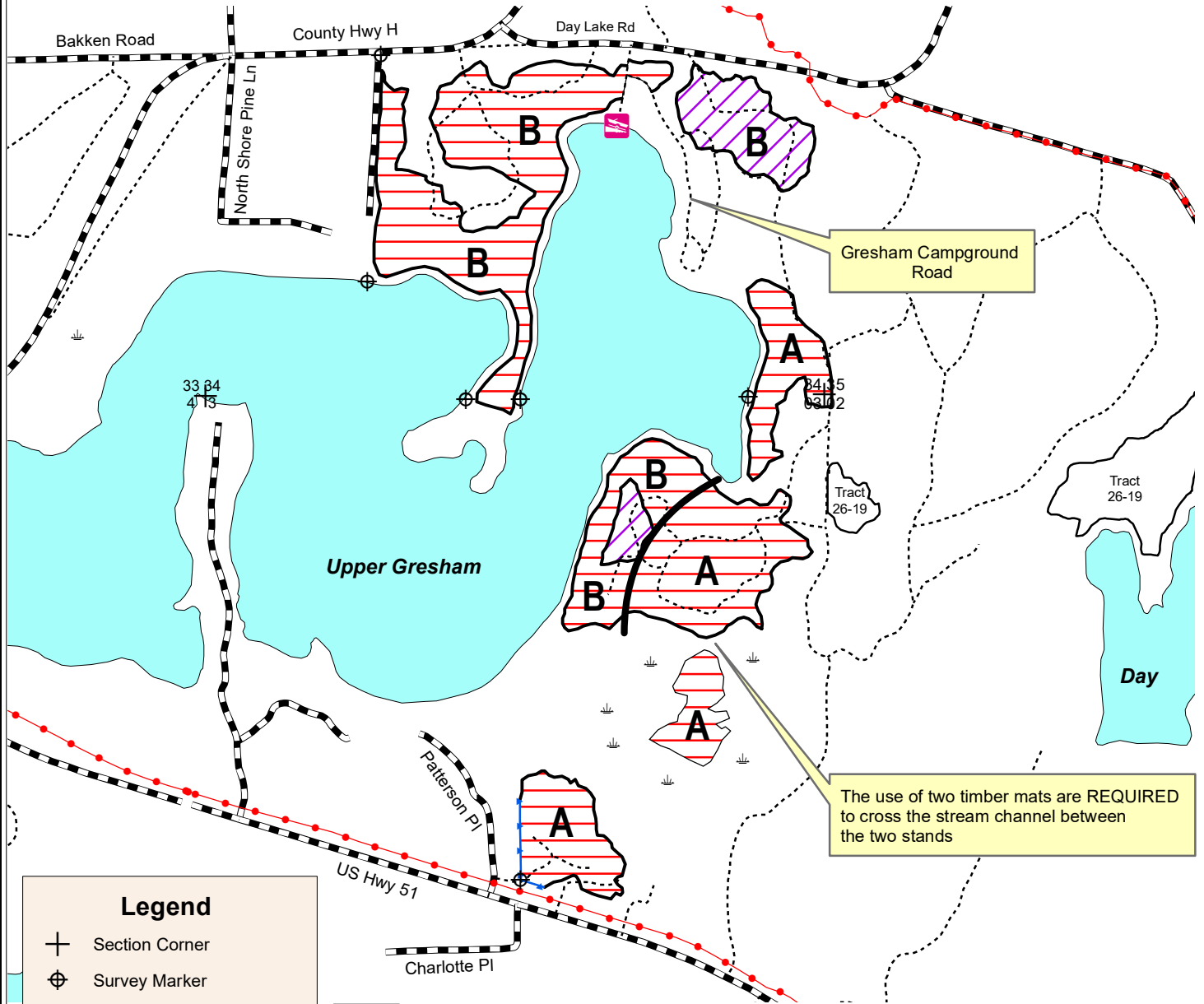

- Cutting Unit 1 (137 Acres): Cut all merchantable aspen, white birch, red maple, balsam fir and spruce. Cut orange marked oak and pine. Cut 1 to 5 inch maple.
- Cutting Unit 2 (19 Acres): Cut same as above EXCEPT do not cut white birch unless marked with orange paint.

**Note: Seasonal Restriction - Zone A can be cut year round.  
Zone B no harvest activity allowed between April 15 and  
October 15.**

**Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.**

The use of two timber mats are REQUIRED  
to cross the stream channel between  
the two stands

4. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.

5. Slash within 50 feet of the private driveway, boat landing road, campground road and campsites must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from the road, boat landing and campsite perimeter.
